SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to safety equipment for certain skateboarders. (BDR 40-474)

EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to public safety; prohibiting the parent or legal guardian of a minor from knowingly allowing the minor to operate certain skateboards unless the minor wears a protective helmet; requiring a person or an agent or employee of a person engaged in the business of renting out certain skateboards to provide a protective helmet to a minor who will operate such a skateboard; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law defines the term “skateboard” and prescribes the conduct to be observed by a person who uses a skateboard park. (NRS 455B.200-455B.300) **Section 3** of this bill defines a “longboard” as a skateboard that has a length and a wheelbase which exceed a certain number of inches. **Section 7** of this bill prohibits the parent or legal guardian of a minor from knowingly allowing the minor to operate a longboard unless the minor wears a protective helmet. **Section 7** also imposes certain fines for persons who violate this provision. **Section 8** of this bill requires, with certain exceptions, a person or an agent or employee of a person engaged in the business of renting out longboards to provide a protective helmet to a minor who will operate a longboard.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 455A of NRS is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto the provisions set forth as sections 2 to 8, inclusive,
3 of this act.

4 **Sec. 2.** *As used in sections 2 to 8, inclusive, of this act, unless
5 the context otherwise requires, the words and terms defined in
6 sections 3 to 6, inclusive, of this act have the meanings ascribed to
7 them in those sections.*

8 **Sec. 3.** *"Longboard" means a skateboard that has a length of
9 at least 36 inches and a wheelbase of at least 20 inches.*

10 **Sec. 4.** *"Minor" means a person who is under 18 years of
11 age.*

12 **Sec. 5.** *"Protective helmet" means headgear which is
13 designed or intended to protect the head of a person who is riding
14 a skateboard and which meets or exceeds:*

15 1. *The ASTM International Standard ASTM F1492-08,
16 "Standard Specification for Helmets Used in Skateboarding and
17 Trick Roller Skating";*

18 2. *The Snell Memorial Foundation Standard N-94, "1994
19 Standard For Protective Headgear For Use in Non-Motorized
20 Sports," including Standard N-94A, "1998 Addendum to the 1994
21 Standard For Protective Headgear For Use in Non-Motorized
22 Sports"; or*

23 3. *Such other standard as may be adopted, recommended or
24 established by the United States Consumer Product Safety
25 Commission, or its successor agency, for skateboarding that is
26 aggressive or involves the performance of tricks.*

27 **Sec. 6.** *"Skateboard" has the meaning ascribed to it in
28 NRS 455B.230.*

29 **Sec. 7.** 1. *The parent or legal guardian of a minor shall not
30 knowingly allow the minor to operate a longboard unless the
31 minor wears a well-fitted protective helmet that is securely
32 fastened on the head of the minor with the straps of the protective
33 helmet.*

34 2. *A parent or legal guardian who violates the provisions of
35 subsection 1 is guilty of a misdemeanor and, except as otherwise
36 provided in subsection 3, shall be punished by a fine of not more
37 than \$10.*

38 3. *For the first offense of the provisions of subsection 1, the
39 court may waive the fine prescribed in subsection 2 and:*

40 (a) *Issue a verbal warning;*

1 (b) *Require the parent or legal guardian to submit proof
2 satisfactory to the court that the person has purchased or
3 otherwise obtained a protective helmet for the minor; or*

4 (c) *Take the actions described in paragraphs (a) and (b).*

5 Sec. 8. *A person or an agent or employee of a person
6 engaged in the business of renting out longboards:*

7 1. *Shall provide a protective helmet to a minor who will be
8 operating a rented longboard if the minor does not have a
9 protective helmet in the minor's possession; and*

10 2. *May charge a reasonable amount for the rental of such a
11 protective helmet.*

12 Sec. 9. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
