SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the powers of the Department of Taxation. (BDR 32-536)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: No.

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EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

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AN ACT relating to taxation; prohibiting the Department of Taxation from issuing a subpoena to compel the production of books and papers that contain individually identifiable health information; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 Existing law authorizes the Department of Taxation to exercise general  
2 supervision and control over the entire revenue system of this State. (NRS 360.200)  
3 Existing law also authorizes the Department to issue subpoenas to compel the  
4 attendance of witnesses and the production of books and papers concerning any  
5 subject material to its responsibilities. (NRS 360.240) This bill prohibits the  
6 Department from issuing a subpoena to compel the production of books and papers  
7 that contain individually identifiable health information.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** NRS 360.240 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2            360.240    1. The Department shall have the power to summon  
3            witnesses to appear and testify on any subject material to its



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1 responsibilities under this title. No property owner and no officer,  
2 director, superintendent, manager or agent of any company or  
3 corporation, whose property is wholly in one county, shall be  
4 required to appear, without his or her consent, at a place other than  
5 the county seat or at the nearest town to his or her place of residence  
6 or the principal place of business of such company or corporation.

7     2. Such summons may be served by personal service by the  
8 Executive Director or his or her agent or by the sheriff of the  
9 county, who shall certify to such service without compensation  
10 therefor.

11     3. ~~If~~ Except as otherwise provided in subsection 4, the  
12 Department may issue subpoenas to compel the attendance of  
13 witnesses and the production of books and papers and may seek to  
14 enforce the subpoenas by petition to any court of competent  
15 jurisdiction in the manner provided by law.

16     4. *The Department shall not issue a subpoena to compel the  
17 production of books and papers that contain individually  
18 identifiable health information.*

19     5. Any member of the Nevada Tax Commission, the Executive  
20 Director or any officer of the Department designated by them may  
21 administer oaths to witnesses.

22     6. *As used in this section, "individually identifiable health  
23 information" means information which identifies a natural  
24 person, or from which the identity of a natural person may  
25 reasonably be ascertained, and which relates to:*

26         (a) *The past, present or future physical or mental health or  
27 condition of the person; or*

28         (b) *The provision of health care to the person.*

29     Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
