AND GUSTAVSON (BY REQUEST)

**SUMMARY**—Requires the State Engineer to allow a county to participate in the development and implementation of a plan relating to the appropriation of water for beneficial use under certain circumstances. (BDR 48-631)

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AN ACT relating to water; requiring the State Engineer to allow a county to participate in the development and implementation of a plan relating to the appropriation of water for beneficial use under certain circumstances; requiring the State Engineer to consider any comment, analysis or other information submitted by a participating county before approving the plan and during the period in which the plan, if approved, is carried out; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1       The State Engineer, an appointee of the Director of the State Department of  
2 Conservation and Natural Resources, manages the appropriation of water in this  
3 State. (Title 48 of NRS) This bill requires the State Engineer to allow a county to  
4 participate in the development and implementation of a plan required by the State  
5 Engineer relating to the appropriation of water for beneficial use if the county  
6 where the proposed point of diversion lies requests to participate. This bill also  
7 requires the State Engineer to consider any comment, analysis or other information  
8 submitted to the State Engineer by the county before approving the plan and during  
9 the period in which the plan, if approved, is carried out.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 532 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      *1. If the State Engineer requires a monitoring, management,  
4 or mitigation plan as a condition of appropriating water for a  
5 beneficial use, the State Engineer shall, if requested by the county  
6 where the proposed point of diversion lies, allow the county to  
7 participate in the development and implementation of the plan.*

8      *2. Before approving any plan developed pursuant to  
9 subsection 1 and during the period in which the plan, if approved,  
10 is carried out, the State Engineer shall consider any comment,  
11 analysis or other information submitted by the participating  
12 county.*

13      **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.

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
