**SUMMARY**—Enacts provisions for the designation of certain hospitals as STEMI receiving centers. (BDR 40-229)

AN ACT relating to public health; enacting provisions for the designation of certain hospitals as STEMI receiving centers; authorizing the State Board of Health to adopt regulations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1       The American Heart Association defines an ST-Elevation Myocardial  
2 Infarction (STEMI) as a severe type of heart attack that is caused by a prolonged  
3 period of blocked blood supply which affects a large area of the heart and which  
4 carries a substantial risk of death and disability. This bill establishes provisions for  
5 the Health Division of the Department of Health and Human Services to  
6 acknowledge and prepare a list of hospitals that are designated as STEMI receiving  
7 centers for meeting the high standards of performance in STEMI care. This bill also  
8 authorizes the State Board of Health to adopt regulations relating to such  
9 designations. This bill further provides that a licensed hospital which is not  
10 designated as a STEMI receiving center may not advertise that the hospital is a  
11 STEMI receiving center. This bill does not prohibit any hospital from providing  
12 care to a victim of a heart attack, even if the hospital does not receive such a  
13 designation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 449 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2 thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      *1. A hospital licensed pursuant to NRS 449.030 to 449.240,  
4 inclusive, may submit to the Health Division proof that the  
5 hospital is accredited as a STEMI receiving center. Upon  
6 receiving proof that a hospital is accredited as a STEMI receiving  
7 center, the Health Division shall include the hospital on the list  
8 established pursuant to subsection 2.*

9      *2. On or before July 1 of each year, the Health Division shall  
10 post a list of all hospitals designated as STEMI receiving centers  
11 on an Internet website maintained by the Health Division.*

12     *3. If a hospital wishes to be included as a STEMI receiving  
13 center on the list established pursuant to subsection 2, the hospital  
14 must annually resubmit the proof required pursuant to this  
15 section.*

16     *4. The Health Division may remove a hospital from the list  
17 established pursuant to subsection 2 if the accreditation  
18 recognizing the hospital as a STEMI receiving center is suspended  
19 or revoked.*

20     *5. A hospital that is not included on the list established  
21 pursuant to subsection 2 shall not represent, advertise or imply  
22 that the hospital is designated as a STEMI receiving center.*

23     *6. The provisions of this section do not prohibit a hospital  
24 that is licensed pursuant to NRS 449.030 to 449.240, inclusive,  
25 from providing care to a victim of a heart attack if the hospital  
26 does not have a designation as a STEMI receiving center.*

27     *7. The Board may adopt regulations to carry out the  
28 provisions of this section and to designate hospitals with  
29 accreditations similar to those required for designation as a  
30 STEMI receiving center.*

31     *8. As used in this section:*

32        *(a) "STEMI" means a myocardial infarction as indicated by  
33 an abnormal elevation of the ST segment of an electrocardiogram  
34 that is administered to a patient.*

35        *(b) "STEMI receiving center" means a hospital that is  
36 accredited by the Society of Cardiovascular Patient Care, in  
37 conjunction with the initiative developed by the American Heart  
38 Association known as the "Mission: Lifeline initiative," or an  
39 equivalent organization approved by the Health Division, as  
40 having met specific standards of performance in the receipt and  
41 treatment of a patient with STEMI.*
