AN ACT relating to inspectors of structures; requiring a certified inspector of a home or other residential structure to provide certain information relating to corrugated stainless steel tubing installed in the structure; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 This bill requires the certified inspector of a home or other residential structure
2 to provide the owner of the structure with certain information relating to corrugated
3 stainless steel tubing if, in the course of an inspection, the certified inspector
4 observes that such tubing is installed in the structure. Specifically, the certified
5 inspector is required to notify the owner of the presence of the tubing and inform
6 the owner that only a licensed electrician is qualified to determine if the tubing is
7 properly bonded and grounded.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** Chapter 645D of NRS is hereby amended by
2 adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

3 ***1. If, in the course of performing an inspection of a
residential structure for the owner of the structure, a certified
inspector observes that corrugated stainless steel tubing is
installed in the structure, the certified inspector shall, in his or her
inspection report:***

8 ***(a) Notify the owner of that fact; and***

1 (b) Inform the owner that only a licensed electrician is
2 qualified to determine whether the corrugated stainless steel
3 tubing is properly bonded and grounded in accordance with:

4 (1) The applicable requirements of the governing building
5 code, law or regulation; and

6 (2) The requirements of the manufacturer's instructions for
7 the installation of the corrugated stainless steel tubing.

8 2. As used in this section:

9 (a) "Corrugated stainless steel tubing" means a flexible pipe
10 fabricated from stainless steel and used to supply natural gas or
11 propane to an appliance in a structure.

12 (b) "Licensed electrician" means a person who is the holder of
13 a license issued by the State Contractors' Board in the specialty of
14 electrical contracting or in a subclassification of such a license
15 which authorizes the person to perform work of the kind described
16 in paragraph (b) of subsection 1.

17 (c) "Residential structure" means a single-family dwelling or
18 any unit in a duplex, triplex, apartment house or condominium of
19 four or fewer dwelling units.
