

SENATE BILL NO. 246—SENATORS JONES AND SPEARMAN

MARCH 13, 2013

Referred to Committee on Legislative Operations and Elections

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to committees for political action. (BDR 24-674)

EXPLANATION – Matter in ***bolded italics*** is new; matter between brackets **[omitted material]** is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to campaign practices; amending the definition of “committee for political action” to include certain organizations and entities that receive contributions or make expenditures in excess of certain amounts for the purpose of affecting an election or ballot question; requiring such organizations and entities to register as committees for political action and report certain information; clarifying that political parties and committees sponsored by political parties are not committees for political action; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Nevada’s elections laws require major and minor political parties and
2 committees sponsored by those political parties to report certain information
3 regarding campaign contributions and expenditures. Nevada’s elections laws also
4 require committees for political action to report certain information regarding
5 campaign contributions and expenditures. (Chapter 294A of NRS)

6 **Section 1** of this bill clarifies that major and minor political parties and
7 committees sponsored by those political parties are not committees for political
8 action under Nevada’s elections laws to ensure that there is no conflict between the
9 provisions governing major and minor political parties and committees sponsored
10 by those political parties and the provisions governing committees for political
11 action. (NRS 294A.0055)

12 **Section 1** also revises the definition of “committee for political action” to
13 include any business or social organization, corporation, partnership, association,
14 trust, unincorporated organization or labor union that: (1) has as its primary purpose
15 affecting the outcome of any election or ballot question and for that purpose
receives in excess of \$1,500 in contributions or makes expenditures in excess of
\$1,500 in a calendar year; or (2) does not have as its primary purpose affecting the

18 outcome of any election or ballot question but for that purpose receives in excess of
19 \$5,000 in contributions or makes expenditures in excess of \$5,000 in a calendar
20 year. (NRS 294A.0055)

21 **Section 2** of this bill requires all such organizations and entities to register with
22 the Secretary of State not later than 7 calendar days after qualifying as a committee
23 for political action and to thereafter comply with the reporting requirements
24 regarding campaign contributions and expenditures. However, if the organization or
25 entity does not have as its primary purpose affecting the outcome of any election or
26 ballot question, it must report only those contributions received for the purpose of
27 affecting the outcome of any election or ballot question. (NRS 294A.230)

28 The provisions of this bill requiring such organizations and entities to register with
29 the Secretary of State as committees for political action and comply with
30 campaign reporting requirements are modeled on statutes enacted by the State of
31 Maine. (Me. Rev. Stat. Ann. tit. 21-A, §§ 1051-1063) The Maine statutes and
32 similar statutes from other jurisdictions have been upheld as constitutionally valid
33 elections laws because they promote an informed electorate by providing voters
34 with pertinent and valuable information about organizations and entities that
35 finance and disseminate elections-related speech. (*Nat'l Org. for Marriage v. McKee*, 649 F.3d 34 (1st Cir. 2011); *Real Truth About Abortion, Inc. v. THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 294A.0055 is hereby amended to read as
2 follows:

3 294A.0055 1. "Committee for political action" means ~~any~~ :
4 (a) **Any** group of natural persons or entities that solicits or
5 receives contributions from any other person, group or entity and:
6 ~~(a)~~ (1) Makes or intends to make contributions to candidates
7 or other persons; or
8 ~~(b)~~ (2) Makes or intends to make expenditures,
9 → designed to affect the outcome of any primary election, primary
10 city election, general election, general city election, special election
11 or question on the ballot.

12 (b) **Any business or social organization, corporation,**
13 **partnership, association, trust, unincorporated organization or**
14 **labor union:**

15 (1) **Which has as its primary purpose affecting the outcome**
16 **of any primary election, primary city election, general election,**
17 **general city election, special election or any question on the ballot**
18 **and for that purpose receives contributions in excess of \$1,500 in**
19 **a calendar year or makes expenditures in excess of \$1,500 in a**
20 **calendar year; or**

21 (2) **Which does not have as its primary purpose affecting**
22 **the outcome of any primary election, primary city election, general**

1 *election, general city election, special election or any question on
2 the ballot, but for the purpose of affecting the outcome of any
3 election or question on the ballot receives contributions in excess
4 of \$5,000 in a calendar year or makes expenditures in excess of
5 \$5,000 in a calendar year.*

6 2. "Committee for political action" does not include:

7 (a) An organization made up of legislative members of a
8 political party whose primary purpose is to provide support for their
9 political efforts.

10 (b) An entity solely because it provides goods or services to a
11 candidate or committee in the regular course of its business at the
12 same price that would be provided to the general public.

13 (c) An individual natural person.

14 (d) ~~And~~ *Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b) of
15 subsection 1, an* individual corporation or other business
16 organization who has filed articles of incorporation or other
17 documentation of organization with the Secretary of State pursuant
18 to title 7 of NRS.

19 (e) ~~And~~ *Except as otherwise provided in paragraph (b) of
20 subsection 1, a* labor union.

21 (f) A personal campaign committee or the personal
22 representative of a candidate who receives contributions or makes
23 expenditures that are reported as campaign contributions or
24 expenditures by the candidate.

25 (g) A committee for the recall of a public officer.

26 (h) *A major or minor political party or any committee
27 sponsored by a major or minor political party.*

28 Sec. 2. NRS 294A.230 is hereby amended to read as follows:

29 294A.230 1. ~~Each~~ *Except as otherwise provided in
30 subsection 2, each* committee for political action shall, before it
31 engages in any activity in this State, register with the Secretary of
32 State on forms supplied by the Secretary of State.

33 2. *A person who qualifies as a committee for political action
34 in accordance with:*

35 (a) *Subparagraph (1) of paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS
36 294A.0055 by receiving contributions in excess of \$1,500 in a
37 calendar year or making expenditures in excess of \$1,500 in a
38 calendar year; or*

39 (b) *Subparagraph (2) of paragraph (b) of subsection 1 of NRS
40 294A.0055 by receiving contributions in excess of \$5,000 in a
41 calendar year or making expenditures in excess of \$5,000 in a
42 calendar year;*

43 *shall, not later than 7 calendar days after the qualifying event,
44 register with the Secretary of State on forms supplied by the
45 Secretary of State. When reporting contributions as required by*

1 **this chapter, a person who qualifies as a committee for political
2 action in accordance with subparagraph (2) of paragraph (b) of
3 subsection 1 of NRS 294A.0055 is required to report only those
4 contributions received for the purpose of affecting the outcome of
5 any primary election, primary city election, general election,
6 general city election, special election or any question on the ballot.**

7 **3.** The form must require:

- 8 (b) The name of the committee ~~H~~**for political action;**
9 (c) The purpose for which it was organized;
10 (d) The names, addresses and telephone numbers of its officers;
11 (e) If the committee for political action is affiliated with any
12 other organizations, the name, address and telephone number of
13 each organization;
14 (f) The name, address and telephone number of its registered
15 agent; and

16 (f) Any other information deemed necessary by the Secretary of
17 State.

18 **~~B~~ 4.** A committee for political action shall file with the
19 Secretary of State:

20 (a) An amended form for registration within 30 days after any
21 change in the information contained in the form for registration.

22 (b) A form for registration on or before January 15 of each year,
23 regardless of whether there is a change in the information contained
24 in the most recent form for registration filed by the committee for
25 political action with the Secretary of State.

26 **~~H~~ 5.** The Secretary of State shall include on the Secretary of
27 State's Internet website the information required pursuant to
28 subsection ~~12~~.

29 **~~H~~ 3.**

30 **6.** For purposes of the civil penalty that the Secretary of State
31 may impose pursuant to NRS 294A.420 for violating the provisions
32 of subsection 1 ~~H~~ **or 2**, if a committee for political action fails to
33 register with the Secretary of State pursuant to subsection 1 ~~H~~ **or 2**,
34 each time the committee for political action engages in any activity
35 in this State constitutes a separate violation of subsection 1 **or 2** for
36 which the Secretary of State may impose a civil penalty.
