

SENATE BILL NO. 262—SENATORS CEGAUSKE AND MANENDO

MARCH 15, 2013

Referred to Committee on Transportation

SUMMARY—Makes various changes relating to vehicles used for advertising. (BDR 43-887)

AN ACT relating to motor vehicles; requiring that certain devices be installed in vehicles that are designed to display certain advertisements while moving over the highways of this State; providing certain requirements concerning the equipment used to display such advertisements; providing a penalty; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 This bill prohibits a person from operating a motor vehicle to which is attached  
2 a dynamic display device, commonly known as a mobile billboard, on which the  
3 images or other content change periodically, upon the highways of this State, unless  
4 the motor vehicle is equipped with a display management system that is  
5 programmed to allow the image or content that is displayed to be changed only  
6 when the motor vehicle is: (1) not moving; or (2) in a location where the image or  
7 content may be changed without causing undue distraction to the operators of other  
8 vehicles. This bill also provides that such a dynamic display device may not project  
9 or otherwise show moving images, moving information or other moving content. A  
10 violation of this prohibition is punishable as a misdemeanor. (NRS 484A.900) This  
11 bill does not require a display management system if a dynamic display device is  
12 operated for purposes other than advertisement.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1       **Section 1.** Chapter 484D of NRS is hereby amended by  
2 adding thereto a new section to read as follows:

3       1. *Except as otherwise provided in subsection 2, a person*  
4 *shall not operate upon the highways of this State any motor*  
5 *vehicle that is equipped with a dynamic display unless:*

6       (a) *The motor vehicle is equipped with a display management*  
7 *system which is configured to prevent the image or content*  
8 *displayed on the dynamic display from changing when the motor*  
9 *vehicle is:*

10           (1) *Moving;*

11           (2) *In a turnout; or*

12           (3) *In any other location where changing the image or*  
13 *content displayed on the dynamic display may cause undue*  
14 *distraction to the operators of other vehicles; and*

15       (b) *The dynamic display does not project or otherwise*  
16 *show moving images, moving information or other moving*  
17 *content.*

18       2. *This section does not prohibit the use of a dynamic display*  
19 *that is operated without a display management system if the*  
20 *dynamic display is being used exclusively for purposes other than*  
21 *advertisement, including, without limitation:*

22       (a) *For purposes that are personal and noncommercial in*  
23 *nature;*

24       (b) *For purposes of traffic control;*

25       (c) *For purposes of law enforcement or emergency response;*

26       (d) *As a warning device for a utility or utility vehicle, as*  
27 *described in NRS 484D.465; or*

28       (e) *To display the name, route number or destination of a bus*  
29 *or other vehicle of mass transit.*

30       3. *As used in this section:*

31       (a) *“Display management system” means equipment or*  
32 *software that is designed to operate a dynamic display, including,*  
33 *without limitation, periodically changing the image, information*  
34 *or content being shown on the dynamic display.*

35       (b) *“Dynamic display” means equipment which is attached to*  
36 *a motor vehicle and which consists of at least one monitor, screen*  
37 *or viewer that, without limitation:*

38           (1) *Is designed to display various images, information or*  
39 *other content, including, without limitation, advertisements, which*  
40 *change periodically;*

41           (2) *Is intended to be visible to the drivers of other vehicles*  
42 *on the highway and to persons who are near the highway; and*

1      *(3) May be visible to the operator of the motor vehicle.*
