AN ACT relating to school districts; expanding the authority of the board of trustees of a school district to issue general obligations; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law enumerates the purposes for which a school district may issue its
2 general obligations. (NRS 387.335) This bill expands the list of authorized
3 purposes to include the purchase of motor vehicles and other equipment used for
4 the transportation of pupils.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** (Deleted by amendment.)

2 **Sec. 2.** NRS 387.335 is hereby amended to read as follows:

3 387.335 1. The board of trustees of a county school district
4 may issue its general obligations to raise money for the following
5 purposes, and no others:

6 (a) Construction, design or purchase of new buildings for
7 schools, including, but not limited to, teacherages, dormitories,
8 dining halls, gymnasiums and stadiums.

9 (b) Enlarging, remodeling or repairing existing buildings or
10 grounds for schools, including, but not limited to, teacherages,
11 dormitories, dining halls, gymnasiums and stadiums.

1 (c) Acquiring sites for building schools, or additional real
2 property for necessary purposes related to schools, including, but
3 not limited to, playgrounds, athletic fields and sites for stadiums.

4 (d) Paying expenses relating to the acquisition of school
5 facilities which have been leased by a school district pursuant to
6 NRS 393.080.

7 (e) Purchasing necessary ***motor vehicles and other equipment***
8 ***to be used for the transportation of pupils or*** furniture and
9 equipment for schools. If money from the issuance of general
10 obligations is used to purchase ***vehicles and other equipment used***
11 ***for the transportation of pupils or*** furniture and equipment to
12 replace existing ***vehicles and equipment or*** furniture and equipment,
13 ***as applicable,*** and ~~that~~ the existing ***vehicles and equipment or***
14 furniture and equipment subsequently ~~is~~ are sold, the proceeds
15 from the sale must be applied toward the retirement of those
16 obligations.

17 2. Any one or more of the purposes enumerated in subsection 1
18 may, by order of the board of trustees entered in its minutes, be
19 united and voted upon as one single proposition.

20 3. Any question submitted pursuant to this section and any
21 question submitted pursuant to NRS 387.3285 may, by order of the
22 board of trustees entered in its minutes, be united and voted upon as
23 a single proposition.

24 **Sec. 3.** The amendatory provisions of section 2 of this act
25 apply only to money raised by general obligations issued by the
26 board of trustees of a school district on or after July 1, 2013.

27 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
