

SENATE BILL NO. 391—SENATORS CEGAVSKE, GOICOECHEA,
HAMMOND, HUTCHISON, ROBERSON; GUSTAVSON,
HARDY AND SETTELMEYER

MARCH 18, 2013

Referred to Committee on Education

SUMMARY—Directs the Legislative Commission to appoint a committee to conduct an interim study concerning the governance structure of and funding methods for community colleges in this State. (BDR S-952)

AN ACT relating to education; directing the Legislative Commission to appoint a committee to conduct an interim study concerning the governance structure of and funding methods for community colleges in this State; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law provides for the administration of community colleges by the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada within the Nevada System of Higher Education. (NRS 396.020) **Section 2** of this bill directs the Legislative Commission to appoint a committee to conduct an interim study concerning the governance structure of and funding methods for community colleges in this State. **Section 3** of this bill requires the committee to appoint two or more subcommittees, including the Subcommittee on Governance and Funding and the Subcommittee on Academics and Workforce Alignment, and to develop the mission and duties of each subcommittee. **Section 3.5** of this bill requires the Legislative Counsel Bureau and the Nevada System of Higher Education to provide administrative and technical assistance to the committee and its subcommittees at the request of the Chair of the committee.



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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:

2 1. The Nevada System of Higher Education, which is governed
3 by the Board of Regents of the University of Nevada, encompasses
4 several different types of institutions of higher education, including,
5 without limitation, community colleges;

6 2. Community colleges are a key component of the State Plan
7 for Economic Development developed by the Executive Director of
8 the Office of Economic Development;

9 3. Certain community colleges have a regional presence for
10 vast areas of rural Nevada;

11 4. Recent economic problems in this State highlight the need
12 for community colleges to be responsive to the students, business
13 communities and regions of this State that they serve; and

14 5. It is important to determine whether a new method of
15 governing and funding community colleges in this State is necessary
16 to improve and advance the purpose of the State's community
17 colleges.

18 **Sec. 2.** 1. The Legislative Commission shall appoint a
19 committee to conduct an interim study concerning the governance
20 structure of and funding methods for community colleges in this
21 State.

22 2. The committee must be composed of six Legislators as
23 follows:

24 (a) Two members appointed by the Majority Leader of the
25 Senate;

26 (b) Two members appointed by the Speaker of the Assembly;

27 (c) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
28 Senate; and

29 (d) One member appointed by the Minority Leader of the
30 Assembly.

31 3. The Majority Leader of the Senate shall appoint a Chair and
32 Vice Chair of the committee.

33 4. The committee shall consult with and solicit input from
34 persons and organizations with expertise in matters relevant to the
35 governance structures of and funding methods for community
36 colleges in this State.

37 5. The committee shall submit a report of its findings,
38 including, without limitation, any proposed changes to the
39 governance structure of or funding methods for community colleges
40 in this State and any recommendations for legislation, to the 78th
41 Session of the Nevada Legislature.



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1 **Sec. 3.** In studying the governance structures of and funding
2 methods for community colleges in this State, the committee
3 appointed pursuant to section 2 shall:

4 1. Appoint two or more subcommittees, which must include:

5 (a) The Subcommittee on Governance and Funding, which
6 consists of:

7 (1) Three members who are members of the committee
8 appointed pursuant to section 2 of this act, appointed by the Chair of
9 the committee;

10 (2) One member who is a member of the Board of Regents of
11 the University of Nevada, appointed by the Chair of the Board;

12 (3) One member who is a representative of K-12 education,
13 appointed by the Superintendent of Public Instruction;

14 (4) Two members who are representatives of local
15 governments, appointed by the Nevada Association of Counties, or
16 its successor organization;

17 (5) One member who is a representative of local
18 governments, appointed by the Nevada League of Cities, or its
19 successor organization; and

20 (6) Any other members appointed by the Chair of the
21 committee.

22 (b) The Subcommittee on Academics and Workforce
23 Alignment, which consists of:

24 (1) Three members who are members of the committee
25 appointed pursuant to section 2 of this act, appointed by the Chair of
26 the committee;

27 (2) One member who is a member of the Board of Regents of
28 the University of Nevada, appointed by the Chair of the Board;

29 (3) Three members who are representatives of the business
30 and economic development communities of this State, one of whom
31 must be a representative of northern Nevada, one of whom must be
32 a representative of southern Nevada and one of whom must be a
33 representative of rural Nevada, appointed by the Executive Director
34 of the Office of Economic Development;

35 (4) One member who is a representative of the Department
36 of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation, appointed by the
37 Director of the Department; and

38 (5) Any other members appointed by the Chair of the
39 committee.

40 2. Develop the mission and duties of each subcommittee
41 appointed pursuant to subsection 1, which must include, without
42 limitation:

43 (a) Reviewing national best practices of governance of and
44 funding methods for community colleges;



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1 (b) Examining effective relationships among local school
2 districts, workforce development and community colleges and
3 making recommendations concerning how this State can strengthen
4 such relationships to improve student achievement;

5 (c) Examining effective relationships between business and
6 industry and community colleges and making recommendations
7 concerning how this State can strengthen such relationships to better
8 prepare students for entry into the workforce;

9 (d) Reviewing the mission of each community college in this
10 State, which must include a determination of whether, over the 10-
11 year period immediately preceding the review, the mission of the
12 community college has changed and whether changes to the
13 academic programs of the community college have enhanced or
14 undermined that mission; and

15 (e) Determining whether it is advisable to transfer the
16 administration of community colleges from the Board of Regents of
17 the University of Nevada to another governmental entity and:

18 (1) If such a transfer is determined to be advisable,
19 determining the best methods of accomplishing the transfer; and

20 (2) If such a transfer is determined not to be advisable,
21 determining whether there are other options available that would
22 improve the governance structure of and funding methods for
23 community colleges.

24 **Sec. 3.5.** The Legislative Counsel Bureau and the Nevada
25 System of Higher Education shall provide administrative and
26 technical assistance to the committee appointed pursuant to section
27 2 of this act and its subcommittees as requested by the Chair of the
28 committee.

29 **Sec. 4.** This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
