

SENATE BILL No. 414—COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

**SUMMARY**—Prohibits transmitting or distributing certain images of bullying involving a child under certain circumstances. (BDR 15-70)

AN ACT relating to juveniles; prohibiting a minor from transmitting or distributing certain images of bullying committed against another minor under certain circumstances; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1      Section 1 of this bill prohibits a minor from knowingly and willfully using an  
2      electronic communication device, such as a cell phone, to transmit or distribute, or  
3      otherwise knowingly and willfully transmitting or distributing, an image of bullying  
4      committed against another minor for the purpose of encouraging, furthering or  
5      promoting bullying and harming the minor. A minor who violates this provision is  
6      considered: (1) for a first violation, a child in need of supervision for the purposes  
7      of the laws governing juvenile justice; and (2) for a second or subsequent violation,  
8      to have committed a delinquent act.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1      **Section 1.** Chapter 200 of NRS is hereby amended by adding  
2      thereto a new section to read as follows:

3      ***1. A minor shall not knowingly and willfully use an***  
4      ***electronic communication device to transmit or distribute, or***  
5      ***otherwise knowingly and willfully transmit or distribute, an image***  
6      ***of bullying committed against a minor to another person with the***

1    *intent to encourage, further or promote bullying and to cause  
2    harm to the minor.*

3    2. *A minor who violates subsection 1:*

4    (a) *For the first violation, is a child in need of supervision, as  
5    that term is used in title 5 of NRS, and is not a delinquent child;  
6    and*

7    (b) *For the second or a subsequent violation, commits a  
8    delinquent act, and the court may order the detention of the minor  
9    in the same manner as if the minor had committed an act that  
10   would have been a misdemeanor if committed by an adult.*

11   3. *For the purposes of this section, to determine whether a  
12   person who is depicted in an image of bullying is a minor, the  
13   court may:*

14      (a) *Inspect the person in question;*

15      (b) *View the image;*

16      (c) *Consider the opinion of a witness to the image regarding  
17   the person's age;*

18      (d) *Consider the opinion of a medical expert who viewed the  
19   image; or*

20      (e) *Use any other method authorized by the rules of evidence  
21   at common law.*

22   4. *As used in this section:*

23      (a) *"Bullying" means a willful act which is written, verbal or  
24   physical, or a course of conduct on the part of one or more  
25   persons which is not otherwise authorized by law and which  
26   exposes a person one time or repeatedly and over time to one or  
27   more negative actions which is highly offensive to a reasonable  
28   person and:*

29        (1) *Is intended to cause or actually causes the person to  
30   suffer harm or serious emotional distress;*

31        (2) *Poses a threat of immediate harm or actually inflicts  
32   harm to another person or to the property of another person;*

33        (3) *Places the person in reasonable fear of harm or serious  
34   emotional distress; or*

35        (4) *Creates an environment which is hostile to a pupil by  
36   interfering with the education of the pupil.*

37      (b) *"Electronic communication device" means any electronic  
38   device that is capable of transmitting or distributing an image of  
39   bullying, including, without limitation, a cellular telephone,  
40   personal digital assistant, computer, computer network and  
41   computer system.*

42      (c) *"Image of bullying" means any visual depiction, including,  
43   without limitation, any photograph or video, of a minor bullying  
44   another minor.*

45      (d) *"Minor" means a person who is under 18 years of age.*

1       **Sec. 2.** NRS 62B.320 is hereby amended to read as follows:  
2       62B.320 1. Except as otherwise provided in this title, the  
3 juvenile court has exclusive original jurisdiction in proceedings  
4 concerning any child living or found within the county who is  
5 alleged or adjudicated to be in need of supervision because the  
6 child:

7           (a) Is subject to compulsory school attendance and is a habitual  
8 truant from school;

9           (b) Habitually disobeys the reasonable and lawful demands of  
10 the parent or guardian of the child and is unmanageable;

11          (c) Deserts, abandons or runs away from the home or usual  
12 place of abode of the child and is in need of care or rehabilitation;  
13 ~~for~~

14          (d) Uses an electronic communication device to transmit or  
15 distribute a sexual image of himself or herself to another person or  
16 to possess a sexual image in violation of NRS 200.737 ~~H~~; or

17           (e) *Transmits or distributes an image of bullying committed  
18 against a minor in violation of section 1 of this act.*

19          2. A child who is subject to the jurisdiction of the juvenile  
20 court pursuant to this section must not be considered a delinquent  
21 child.

22          3. As used in this section:

23           (a) *“Bullying” means a willful act which is written, verbal or  
24 physical, or a course of conduct on the part of one or more  
25 persons which is not otherwise authorized by law and which  
26 exposes a person one time or repeatedly and over time to one or  
27 more negative actions which is highly offensive to a reasonable  
28 person and:*

29              (i) *Is intended to cause or actually causes the person to  
30 suffer harm or serious emotional distress;*

31              (ii) *Poses a threat of immediate harm or actually inflicts  
32 harm to another person or to the property of another person;*

33              (iii) *Places the person in reasonable fear of harm or serious  
34 emotional distress; or*

35              (iv) *Creates an environment which is hostile to a pupil by  
36 interfering with the education of the pupil.*

37           (b) “Electronic communication device” has the meaning  
38 ascribed to it in NRS 200.737.

39           ~~(b)~~ (c) “Sexual image” has the meaning ascribed to it in  
40 NRS 200.737.
