SUMMARY—Revises certain provisions relating to pari-mutuel wagering. (BDR 41-1111)

AN ACT relating to gaming; revising certain provisions relating to pari-mutuel wagering; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law prohibits a person who is licensed to engage in off-track pari-
2 mutuel wagering from: (1) accepting less than the full face value of an off-track
3 pari-mutuel wager; (2) agreeing to refund or rebate a portion or percentage of the
4 full face value of an off-track pari-mutuel wager; or (3) increasing the payoff of or
5 paying a bonus on a winning off-track pari-mutuel wager. (NRS 464.075) This bill
6 instead authorizes a person who is licensed to engage in off-track pari-mutuel
7 wagering to accept certain wagers, agree to refunds or rebates, increase payoffs or
8 pay bonuses on off-track pari-mutuel wagers, unless the Nevada Gaming
9 Commission otherwise prohibits such conduct by regulation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

3 **Sec. 3.** NRS 464.075 is hereby amended to read as follows:

4 464.075 1. Except as otherwise provided in ~~subsection~~
5 **subsections** 4 ~~4~~ and 5, a person who is licensed to engage in off-

6 track pari-mutuel wagering ~~shall not~~ may:

7 (a) Accept from a patron less than the full face value of an off-
8 track pari-mutuel wager;

1 (b) Agree to refund or rebate to a patron any portion or
2 percentage of the full face value of an off-track pari-mutuel wager;
3 or

4 (c) Increase the payoff of, or pay a bonus on, a winning off-track
5 pari-mutuel wager.

6 2. A person who is licensed to engage in off-track pari-mutuel
7 wagering and who:

8 (a) Attempts to evade the provisions of subsection ~~H~~ 4 by
9 offering to a patron a wager that is not posted and offered to all
10 patrons; or

11 (b) Otherwise violates the provisions of subsection ~~H~~ 4,

12 is subject to the investigatory and disciplinary proceedings that
13 are set forth in NRS 463.310 to 463.318, inclusive, and shall be
14 punished as provided in those sections.

15 3. The Nevada Gaming Commission ~~shall~~ *may* adopt
16 regulations to carry out the provisions of subsections ~~H~~ and 2 ~~of~~

18 4. The Nevada Gaming Commission may, by regulation,
19 ~~exempt~~ *prohibit* certain bets, refunds, rebates, payoffs or bonuses

24 *5. A person who is licensed to engage in off-track pari-*
25 *mutuel wagering may not accept* bets, *agree to* refunds ~~H~~ or
26 *rebates, increase* payoffs or *pay* bonuses that would result in the
27 amount of such bets, refunds, rebates, payoffs or bonuses being
28 directly or indirectly deductible from gross revenue. ~~may not be~~
29 ~~exempt.~~

30 Sec. 4. This act becomes effective:

31 1. Upon passage and approval for the purpose of adopting
32 regulations; and

33 2. On October 1, 2013, for all other purposes.
