

SENATE BILL NO. 462—COMMITTEE ON FINANCE
(ON BEHALF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION)

SUMMARY—Makes an appropriation to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within the Department of Public Safety for the initial phase of the project to modernize the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System. (BDR S-1184)

AN ACT making an appropriation to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within the Department of Public Safety for the initial phase of the project to modernize the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within the Department of Public Safety the sum of \$2,315,090 for the initial phase of the project to modernize the Nevada Criminal Justice Information System.

Sec. 2. Any remaining balance of the appropriation made by section 1 of this act must not be committed for expenditure after June 30, 2015, by the Central Repository for Nevada Records of Criminal History within the Department of Public Safety or any entity to which money from the appropriation is granted or otherwise transferred in any manner, and any portion of the



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1 appropriated money remaining must not be spent for any purpose
2 after September 18, 2015, by either the Central Repository for
3 Nevada Records of Criminal History or the entity to which the
4 money was subsequently granted or transferred, and must be
5 reverted to the State General Fund on or before September 18, 2015.
6 **Sec. 3.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
