SUMMARY—Revises certain fees collected by the Administrator of the Commission on Postsecondary Education. (BDR 34-1135)

AN ACT relating to education; revising certain fees collected by the Administrator of the Commission on Postsecondary Education; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

- 1 Existing law authorizes the Administrator of the Commission on Postsecondary
2 Education to collect certain fees from certain private postsecondary educational
3 institutions. (NRS 394.540) This bill increases certain fees collected by the
4 Administrator and imposes a new fee on such postsecondary educational
5 institutions for approval of applications to offer an alcohol awareness program.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 394.540 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 394.540 1. The fees imposed pursuant to this section must be
3 collected by the Administrator and deposited in the State Treasury
4 to the credit of the State General Fund, and no fees so collected are
5 subject to refund.
6 2. The fees are:
7 (a) For a new license.....~~[\$1,500]~~ ***\$2,000***

2	state educational institution to employ agents in	
3	this state <i>or offer experiential courses</i>	1,000 <i>1,500</i>
4	(c) For a change of ownership	750 <i>1,000</i>

13	3. In addition, the Administrator shall collect from each	
14	licensed postsecondary educational institution a fee of \$4 for each	
15	student from which the institution has received tuition or registration	
16	fees. The institution shall collect this fee from each such student at	
17	the time of the student's initial enrollment with the institution. On or	
18	before the first day of January, April, July and October, the	
19	institution shall transmit to the Administrator the fees collected	
20	pursuant to this subsection during the preceding quarter. The	
21	Administrator shall deposit the fees so transmitted with the State	
22	Treasurer for credit to the State General Fund.	
23	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2013.
