AN ACT relating to cancer; allowing certain licensed physicians to  
dispense cancer drugs donated for use in the Cancer Drug  
Donation Program; and providing other matters properly  
relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel’s Digest:**

- 1 Under existing law, only a registered pharmacist may dispense a cancer drug
- 2 donated for use in the Cancer Drug Donation Program. (NRS 457.460) This bill
- 3 allows a registered pharmacist or certain licensed physicians to dispense a cancer
- 4 drug donated for use in the Program.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 457.460 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 2 457.460 A cancer drug donated for use in the Program may
- 3 only be dispensed:
- 4 1. By a pharmacist who is registered pursuant to chapter 639 of
- 5 NRS ~~§~~ *or by a physician who is licensed pursuant to chapter 630*
- 6 *or 633 of NRS;*
- 7 2. Pursuant to a prescription written by a person who is
- 8 authorized to write prescriptions; and



- 1 3. To a person who is eligible to receive cancer drugs
- 2 dispensed pursuant to the Program.
