

SENATE BILL NO. 83—COMMITTEE ON NATURAL RESOURCES

PREFILED JANUARY 31, 2013

Referred to Committee on Natural Resources

SUMMARY—Revises provisions relating to animal fighting. (BDR 50-148)

FISCAL NOTE: Effect on Local Government: Increases or Newly Provides for Term of Imprisonment in County or City Jail or Detention Facility. Effect on the State: Yes.

AN ACT relating to cruelty to animals; increasing the penalties for certain offenses related to the use of an animal or a bird for baiting or fighting; prohibiting a person from manufacturing, owning or possessing a gaff, spur or other sharp implement designed for attachment to a cock or other bird with the intent that it be used in fighting another cock or other bird under certain circumstances; providing penalties; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel’s Digest:

1 Under existing law, a person who owns, occupies or is otherwise connected in
2 certain ways to a house, apartment, pit or place kept or used for baiting or fighting
3 any bird or animal is subject to criminal penalties. A first offense is punishable as a
4 gross misdemeanor, a second offense is punishable as a category E felony and a
5 third or subsequent offense is punishable as a category D felony. (NRS 574.060)
6 **Section 1** of this bill increases those penalties to make the first offense punishable
7 as a category E felony and a second or subsequent offense punishable as a category
8 D felony.
9 Existing law imposes criminal penalties against a person who: (1) takes certain
10 actions in furtherance of a fight between animals under certain circumstances; (2)
11 owns, possesses, keeps, trains, promotes or purchases an animal with the intent to
12 use it to fight another animal; or (3) sells an animal knowing that it is intended to be
13 used to fight another animal. A first offense is punishable as a gross misdemeanor,
14 a second offense is punishable as a category E felony and a third or subsequent
15 offense is punishable as a category D felony. (NRS 574.070) **Section 2** of this bill
16 increases those penalties to make the first offense punishable as a category E felony
17 and a second or subsequent offense punishable as a category D felony.



18 Existing law also imposes criminal penalties against a person who knowingly
19 witnesses a fight between animals in an exhibition or for amusement or gain. A first
20 offense is punishable as a misdemeanor, a second offense is punishable as a gross
21 misdemeanor and a third or subsequent offense is punishable as a category E
22 felony. (NRS 574.070) **Section 2** of this bill increases those penalties to make the
23 first offense punishable as a gross misdemeanor and a second or subsequent offense
24 punishable as a category E felony. **Section 2** also imposes the same criminal
25 penalties on a person who manufactures, owns, possesses, sells, barter or
26 exchanges, or advertises for sale, barter or exchange, certain sharp instruments
27 designed to be attached to certain fighting birds.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 **Section 1.** NRS 574.060 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 574.060 1. A person shall not keep or use, or in any manner
3 be connected with, or be interested in the management of, or receive
4 money for the admission of any person to, a house, apartment, pit or
5 place kept or used for baiting or fighting any bird or animal, or be an
6 owner or occupant of a house, apartment, pit or place who willfully
7 procures or permits the same to be used or occupied for such baiting
8 or fighting.

9 2. A person who violates any provision of subsection 1 is
10 guilty of:

11 (a) For a first offense, a ~~gross misdemeanor~~ *category E felony*
12 *and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.*

13 (b) For a second ~~offense, a category E felony and shall be~~
14 ~~punished as provided in NRS 193.130.~~

15 ~~—(c) For a third~~ or subsequent offense, a category D felony and
16 shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.

17 3. Upon complaint under oath or affirmation to any magistrate
18 authorized to issue warrants in criminal cases that the complainant
19 has just and reasonable cause to suspect that any provision of law
20 relating to or in any way affecting animals is being or is about to be
21 violated in any particular building or place, the magistrate shall
22 immediately issue and deliver a warrant to any person authorized by
23 law to make arrests for such offenses, authorizing the person to
24 enter and search the building or place, to arrest any person there
25 present found violating any such law and to bring the person before
26 the nearest magistrate of competent jurisdiction to be dealt with
27 according to law.

28 **Sec. 2.** NRS 574.070 is hereby amended to read as follows:

29 574.070 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, a
30 person shall not begin, cause, instigate, promote, carry on or do any
31 act as an assistant, umpire or principal, or in any way aid in or
32 engage in the furtherance of any fight between animals in an



1 exhibition or for amusement or gain which is premeditated by a
2 person owning or having custody of the animals.

3 2. A person shall not:

4 (a) Own, possess, keep, train, promote or purchase an animal
5 with the intent to use it to fight another animal; or

6 (b) Sell an animal knowing that it is intended to be used to fight
7 another animal.

8 3. A person shall not ~~knowingly~~ :

9 (a) *Knowingly* witness any fight between animals in an
10 exhibition or for amusement or gain ~~†~~ ; or

11 (b) *Manufacture, own, possess, purchase, sell, barter or*
12 *exchange, or advertise for sale, barter or exchange, any gaff, spur*
13 *or other sharp implement designed for attachment to a cock or*
14 *other bird with the intent that the implement be used in fighting*
15 *another cock or other bird.*

16 4. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 7, a person who
17 violates any provision of subsection 1 is guilty of:

18 (a) For a first offense, a ~~gross misdemeanor~~ *category E felony*
19 *and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.*

20 (b) For a second ~~offense, a category E felony and shall be~~
21 ~~punished as provided in NRS 193.130.~~

22 ~~(c) For a third~~ or subsequent offense, a category D felony and
23 shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.

24 5. A person who violates any provision of subsection 2 is
25 guilty of:

26 (a) For a first offense, a ~~gross misdemeanor~~ *category E felony*
27 *and shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.*

28 (b) For a second ~~offense, a category E felony and shall be~~
29 ~~punished as provided in NRS 193.130.~~

30 ~~(c) For a third~~ or subsequent offense, a category D felony and
31 shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.

32 6. A person who violates any provision of subsection 3 is
33 guilty of:

34 (a) For a first offense, a *gross* misdemeanor.

35 (b) For a second ~~offense, a gross misdemeanor.~~

36 ~~(c) For a third~~ or subsequent offense, a category E felony and
37 shall be punished as provided in NRS 193.130.

38 7. If a violation of subsection 1 involves a dog, a person who
39 commits such a violation is guilty of:

40 (a) For a first offense, a category D felony and shall be punished
41 as provided in NRS 193.130.

42 (b) For a second offense, a category C felony and shall be
43 punished as provided in NRS 193.130.

44 (c) For a third or subsequent offense, a category B felony and
45 shall be punished by imprisonment in the state prison for a



1 minimum term of not less than 1 year and a maximum term of not
2 more than 6 years.

3 8. If a person who violates this section is not a natural person,
4 the person shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$10,000.

5 9. This section does not prohibit the use of dogs or birds for:

6 (a) The management of livestock by the owner thereof, the
7 owner's employees or agents or any other person in the lawful
8 custody of the livestock; or

9 (b) Hunting as permitted by law.
