We have three bill draft requests (BDRs) that require Committee introduction, and I would like to introduce them today. Please note that voting in favor of introducing a BDR does not imply a commitment to support the measure later. This action just allows the BDR to become a bill and be referred to the Committee for possible hearings. The first BDR relates to federal public lands in Nevada. It is BDR R-208. May I have a motion for Committee introduction?

BDR R-208—Urges Congress to take certain actions concerning federal public lands in Nevada. (Later introduced as Assembly Joint Resolution 5.)
