<u>SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 4</u>: Urges the Government of Turkey to grant the Ecumenical Patriarch international recognition and to respect the human rights and property rights of the Ecumenical Patriarchate. (BDR R-885)

### Senator Barbara K. Cegavske, Senatorial District No. 8:

I will read from prepared testimony (Exhibit C).

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Jon Caredis (Vice President, Pan Arcadian Federation, Alea Chapter, Las Vegas): I approached Senator Cegavske with this issue several months ago. She agreed to have legislation drafted without regard to party affiliation. This is not anti-Turkish—it is a human rights and religious freedom issue. I urge all of you to pass this resolution to stand behind religious freedom.

## **Chair Spearman:**

Is the issue a litmus test with respect to religious beliefs in regard to the Ecumenical Patriarch of Turkey? Are Orthodox Christians being ostracized because they ascribe to the Orthodox Christian religious or theological beliefs?
