<u>S.B. 5</u> (R1)	Revises provisions governing elections for nonpartisan offices. (BDR 24-90)
<u>S.B. 19</u> (R1)	Authorizes the board of trustees of a school district to place an advisory question on the ballot at a general election. (BDR 24-477)
<u>S.J.R. 3</u> (R1)	Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to provide for the Lieutenant Governor to be elected jointly with the Governor. (BDR C-486)
<u>S.J.R. 17</u> (R1)	Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to expand the rights guaranteed to victims of crime. (BDR C-952)

<u>S.B. 248</u> (R1)	Revises provisions relating to the provision of assistance to certain voters. (BDR 24-982)
<u>S.J.R. 1</u> (R1)	Urges Congress to enact legislation transferring title to certain public lands to the State of Nevada in accordance with the report prepared by the Nevada Land Management Task Force. (BDR R-451)
<u>S.J.R. 5</u> (R1)	Expresses support for the 2014 Nevada Greater Sage-Grouse Conservation Plan developed by the Sagebrush Ecosystem Council and urges the United States Fish and Wildlife Service not to list the greater sage-grouse
	as endangered or threatened under the Endangered Species Act of 1973. (BDR R-480)
