<u>S.B. 274 (</u> R1)	Enacts provisions governing the State's delegates to any federal constitutional conventions. (BDR 24-600)
<u>S.B. 293</u> (R1)	Revises provisions relating to the disposition of unspent campaign contributions. (BDR 24-596)
S.B. 307	Revises provisions relating to public officers and candidates for public office. (BDR 17-768)
<u>S.B. 403</u> (R1)	Revises provisions relating to elections. (BDR 24-799)
S.B. 499 (R1)	Revises certain deadlines relating to elections. (BDR 24-1149)
<u>S.J.R. 3</u> (R1)	Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to provide for the Lieutenant Governor to be elected jointly with the Governor. (BDR C-486)
<u>S.J.R. 17 (</u> R1)	Proposes to amend the Nevada Constitution to expand the rights guaranteed to victims of crime. (BDR C-952)
