SUMMARY—Revises provisions governing the Public Employees' Retirement Board. (BDR 23-185)

EXPLANATION - Matter in bolded italics is new; matter between brackets [omitted material] is material to be omitted.

AN ACT relating to the Public Employees' Retirement Board; revising provisions governing the size and composition of the Board; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law requires the Public Employees' Retirement System to be governed by the Public Employees' Retirement Board, consisting of seven persons appointed by the Governor. (NRS 286.120) **Section 1** of this bill increases the size of the Board to nine persons. Existing law requires one member of the Board to be a person who: (1) is an employee of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions with at least 10 years of service; (2) is serving in a position at least equivalent to the manager of a department or division; (3) is not an elected officer of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions; and (4) is an active member of the System. (NRS 286.130) Section 2 of this bill removes this requirement and instead requires three members of the Board to be persons who: (1) have specified experience relating to the design or management of retirement plans; (2) are not employees of the State or its political subdivisions; (3) are not elected officers of the State or its political subdivisions; and (4) have never been active members of the System. Section 3 of this bill provides for the continued service, during the present term, of the member of the Board who was appointed pursuant to the existing provisions of the statute and establishes staggered terms for the newly-appointed members.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 286.120 is hereby amended to read as follows: 286.120 1. The governing authority of the System shall be a board of [seven] *nine* persons appointed by the Governor.

- 2. The name of the board shall be the Public Employees' Retirement Board.
 - 3. The Governor shall review periodically the broad administrative policies and performance standards as they are being administered by the Board.
 - 4. The Governor may remove and replace any Board member for cause shown.
 - **Sec. 2.** NRS 286.130 is hereby amended to read as follows:
 - 286.130 1. Three members of the Board must be persons who:
 - (a) Have had at least 10 years of service as employees of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions;
 - (b) Are not elected officers of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions;
 - (c) Are active members of the System; and
 - (d) Are appointed from written nominations submitted by the following groups:
 - (1) Employees of the State and the Nevada System of Higher Education;
 - (2) The academic staff of school districts;
 - (3) Employees of cities, excluding Carson City;
 - (4) Employees of counties, including Carson City and excluding employees of county hospitals;
 - (5) Employees of county hospitals, public utilities, power districts, sanitation districts, classified school employees and employees of other districts as determined by the Board; and
 - (6) Employees whose current positions entitle them to participate in the Police and Firefighters' Retirement Fund.
 - Each nominee must be a member of the group or organization that is nominating the nominee.
 - 2. Two members of the Board must be persons who:
 - (a) Have had at least 10 years of service as employees of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions;
 - (b) Are not elected officers of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions;
 - (c) Are active members of the System; and
 - (d) Are appointed from written nominations submitted by the following groups:
 - (1) Administrators of school districts or members of boards of trustees of school districts; and
 - (2) Members of boards of county commissioners or the governing bodies of cities or administrators of counties or cities.
- 3. [One member] Three members of the Board must be [a person] persons who:





- (a) [Is an employee] Have demonstrated experience in the design or management of retirement plans, accounting for such plans or the application of actuarial principles to such plans, or any combination of these;
- (b) Are not employees of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions; [with at least 10 years of service;
- (b) Is serving in a position at least equivalent to the manager of a department or division;]
- (c) [Is] Are not [an] elected [officer] officers of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions; and
- (d) [Is an] Have never been active [member] members of the System.
 - 4. One member of the board must be a person who:
- (a) Has had at least 10 years of service as an employee of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions;
- (b) Is not an elected officer of the State of Nevada or its political subdivisions; and
- (c) Is receiving an allowance for service or disability retirement pursuant to this chapter.
- 5. A member of the Board shall serve for 4 years, so long as the member has the qualifications required by this section, and until the member's successor is appointed and takes office. A member of the Board who no longer has the qualifications specified in the subsection under which the member was appointed may serve the remainder of the member's term if the member loses those qualifications in the final 24 months of the member's term.
- **Sec. 3.** 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 3 of NRS 286.130, as amended by section 2 of this act, the term of the member of the Public Employees' Retirement Board who:
- (a) Was appointed to a term beginning on July 1, 2013, pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 286.130, as it existed on that date; and
 - (b) Is serving on July 1, 2015,
- rightharpoologies expires on June 30, 2017. That member must be succeeded by a member appointed pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 286.130, as amended by section 2 of this act.
- 2. As soon as practicable on or after July 1, 2015, the Governor shall appoint to the Public Employees' Retirement Board two of the members required to be appointed pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 286.130, as amended by section 2 of this act. The Governor shall designate one such member to serve until June 30, 2018, and the other until June 30, 2019.
