- 1 WHEREAS, Since the launching of the Global War on Terrorism
- 2 in response to attacks on the United States on September 11, 2001,
- 3 through Operation Enduring Freedom, Operation Iraqi Freedom,
- 4 Operation New Dawn, Operation Inherent Resolve and Operation
- 5 Freedom’s Sentinel, 6,832 Americans have lost their lives, including
- 6 56 Nevadans; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The service of these men and women required
- 8 sacrifice, hardship, endurance, dedication, courage and the highest
- 9 level of patriotism; and

1 WHEREAS, Those Nevada citizens who served our country in the  
2 name of freedom and justice deserve special recognition for their  
3 sacrifices; and

4 WHEREAS, While the members of the Armed Forces of the  
5 United States, including the members of Nevada's National Guard,  
6 continue to risk their lives and protect the interests of our country,  
7 the State of Nevada has not lost one of its own since January 2012;  
8 now, therefore, be it

9 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, THE  
10 SENATE CONCURRING, That we must continue to honor every  
11 American who served and those who are still serving, and extend  
12 our heartfelt condolences to the Nevada friends and family members  
13 of those who made the ultimate sacrifice; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That while we are grateful that no more Nevadans  
15 have been lost to the Global War on Terrorism, we continue to  
16 honor the fifty-six Nevadans who we have recognized in previous  
17 legislative sessions; and be it further

18 RESOLVED, That we pause to reflect on the supreme sacrifice of  
19 the fifty-six Nevadans who have given their lives in the pursuit of  
20 freedom as well as those who continue to serve our country in the  
21 name of freedom; and be it further

22 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and  
23 transmit a copy of this resolution to Kat Miller, Director of the  
24 Department of Veterans Services, and additional copies of this  
25 resolution to Kat Miller for provision to Nevada's veterans services  
26 organizations in recognition of their commitment to the men and  
27 women who served, and continue to serve, in the Armed Forces of  
28 the United States.
