AN ACT relating to the security of personal information; expanding the definition of "personal information"; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Existing law defines the types of information that constitute "personal information" for the purpose of requiring business entities who collect such information to provide certain security measures to ensure the protection of the information. (Chapter 603A of NRS) This bill expands the definition of "personal information" to include such items of information as electronic mail addresses and passwords, **[passport_numbers_t]* driver's authorization card numbers_ medical and health insurance identification numbers_t, electronic signatures_t and other similar information_ that would increase a person's likelihood of becoming a victim of identity theft.]

Sec. 8.5. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 9 of this act, a data collector, as that term is defined in NRS 603A.030, or a business is not required to comply with the amendatory provisions of this act until July 1, 2016.

Sec. 9. This act becomes effective on July 1, 2015.
