AN ACT making a supplemental appropriation to the Department of Corrections for a shortfall resulting from a reduction in certain transfers for prison medical care; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the State General Fund to the Department of Corrections the sum of ~~(\$1,224,571)~~ ***\$1,193,577*** for an unanticipated shortfall in transfers from the Inmate Welfare Account for prison medical care for Fiscal Year 2014-2015. This appropriation is supplemental to that made in section 22 of chapter 446, Statutes of Nevada 2013, at page 2598.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
