SUMMARY—Provides for the rolling reissuance of license plates by the Department of Motor Vehicles. (BDR 43-1179)

AN ACT relating to license plates; providing for the reissuance of new license plates by the Department of Motor Vehicles at certain intervals to replace existing license plates; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

Under existing law, the Department of Motor Vehicles is required to furnish to every owner whose vehicle is required to be registered two license plates for a motor vehicle other than a motorcycle and one license plate for all other vehicles, including, without limitation, a motorcycle, a trailer and certain farm tractors or self-propelled implements of husbandry. (NRS 482.265, 482.276) Existing law provides that, in addition to any other fee, the Department may by regulation impose a fee to defray the cost of issuing a license plate. (NRS 482.268) **Section 2** of this bill requires the Department to reissue a license plate or plates issued by the Department every 8 years, and authorizes the Director of the Department to provide procedures for such reissuance in regulations. **Section 1** of this bill provides for the reissuance of such a plate for a trailer with a 3-year registration period at the first renewal of registration that occurs after the existing plate has been issued for 8 years. (NRS 482.2065) **Section 6** of this bill requires the Department, at the time when a license plate or a set of plates is to be reissued, to include with the notification of renewal of registration for the plate or plates the amount of any fee to be charged for the reissuance. (NRS 482.280)

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 482.2065 is hereby amended to read as follows:
482.2065 1. A trailer may be registered for a 3-year period as provided in this section.
2. A person who registers a trailer for a 3-year period must pay upon registration all fees and taxes that would be due during the 3-year period if he or

1 she registered the trailer for 1 year and renewed that registration for 2 consecutive
2 years immediately thereafter, including, without limitation:

3 (a) Registration fees pursuant to NRS 482.480 and 482.483.

4 (b) A fee for each license plate issued pursuant to NRS 482.268.

5 (c) Fees for the initial issuance, *reissuance* and renewal of a special license
6 plate pursuant to NRS 482.265, if applicable.

7 (d) Fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a personalized prestige license
8 plate pursuant to NRS 482.367, if applicable.

9 (e) Additional fees for the initial issuance and renewal of a special license plate
10 issued pursuant to NRS 482.3667 to 482.3823, inclusive, which are imposed to
11 generate financial support for a particular cause or charitable organization, if
12 applicable.

13 (f) Governmental services taxes imposed pursuant to chapter 371 of NRS, as
14 provided in NRS 482.260.

15 (g) The applicable taxes imposed pursuant to chapters 372, 374, 377 and 377A
16 of NRS.

17 3. *A license plate issued pursuant to this section will be reissued as provided*
18 *in NRS 482.265 except that such reissuance will be done at the first renewal after*
19 *the license plate has been issued for not less than 8 years.*

20 4. As used in this section, the term "trailer" does not include a full trailer or
21 semitrailer that is registered pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 482.483.

22 **Sec. 2.** NRS 482.265 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 482.265 1. The Department shall furnish to every owner whose vehicle is
24 registered two license plates for a motor vehicle other than a motorcycle and one
25 license plate for all other vehicles required to be registered hereunder. Upon
26 renewal of registration, the Department may issue one or more license plate
27 stickers, tabs or other suitable devices in lieu of new license plates.

28 2. *Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.2065, every 8 years the*
29 *Department shall reissue a license plate or plates at the time of renewal of each*
30 *license plate or plates issued pursuant to this chapter. The Director may adopt*
31 *regulations to provide procedures for such reissuance.*

32 3. The Director shall have the authority to require the return to the
33 Department of all number plates upon termination of the lawful use thereof by the
34 owner under this chapter.

35 ~~4.~~ 4. Except as otherwise specifically provided by statute, for the issuance
36 of each special license plate authorized pursuant to this chapter:

37 (a) The fee to be received by the Department for the initial issuance of the
38 special license plate is \$35, exclusive of any additional fee which may be added to
39 generate funds for a particular cause or charitable organization;

40 (b) The fee to be received by the Department for the renewal of the special
41 license plate is \$10, exclusive of any additional fee which may be added to generate
42 financial support for a particular cause or charitable organization; and

43 (c) The Department shall not design, prepare or issue a special license plate
44 unless, within 4 years after the date on which the measure authorizing the issuance
45 becomes effective, it receives at least 250 applications for the issuance of that plate.

46 ~~5.~~ 5. The provisions of subsection ~~4.~~ 4 do not apply to NRS 482.37901.

47 **Sec. 3.** NRS 482.266 is hereby amended to read as follows:

48 482.266 1. A person who desires to have regular or personalized license
49 plates that are substantially in the same color and form as license plates
50 manufactured before January 1, 1982, must:

51 (a) Submit a written request for such license plates to the Department in a
52 manner and form prescribed by the Department; and

(b) In addition to all other applicable registration fees, licensing fees and governmental services taxes, pay the manufacturing fee prescribed by the Department.

➤ A person requesting license plates pursuant to this section must comply with all requirements for registration and licensing pursuant to this chapter. A request for license plates pursuant to this section does not, by itself, constitute a request for special license plates pursuant to subsection ~~3~~ 4 of NRS 482.265.

2. After receiving a request and the full amount of the payment due for license plates requested pursuant to subsection 1, the Department shall manufacture the license plates using substantially the same process, dies and materials as were used to manufacture license plates before January 1, 1982. The Department shall deliver license plates requested pursuant to this section to a person who requests such license plates within 180 days after acceptance of the written request or after receipt of payment therefor, whichever occurs last.

3. The Department shall:

(a) Prescribe, by regulation, a manner and form for submitting a written request pursuant to subsection 1. The form must include, without limitation, an indication of whether the requester desires to have the same letters and numbers on the license plates requested as are on the license plates that are registered to the requester at the time of the request.

(b) Determine the cost of manufacturing a license plate pursuant to this section and prescribe a manufacturing fee, which must not exceed \$25, to defray the cost of manufacturing license plates pursuant to this section. The manufacturing fee must be:

(1) Collected by the Department;

(2) Deposited with the State Treasurer to the credit of the State Highway Fund; and

(3) Allocated to the Revolving Account for the Issuance of Special License Plates created pursuant to NRS 482.1805 to defray the costs of manufacturing license plates pursuant to this section.

4. A person who requests license plates pursuant to this section may keep the license plates which are registered to him or her at the time of the request if the license plates requested contain the same letters and numbers as the license plates which are registered to the person at the time of the request.

Sec. 4. NRS 482.270 is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.270 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section or by specific statute, the Director shall order the redesign and preparation of motor vehicle license plates.

2. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 3, the Department ~~{shall,}~~ may, upon the payment of all applicable fees, issue redesigned motor vehicle license plates. ~~{pursuant to this section to persons who apply for the registration or renewal of the registration of a motor vehicle on or after January 1, 2001.}~~

3. The Department shall not issue redesigned motor vehicle license plates pursuant to this section to a person who was issued motor vehicle license plates before January 1, 1982, or pursuant to NRS 482.3747, 482.3763, ~~{482.3775, 482.378,}~~ 482.379 or 482.37901, without the approval of the person.

4. The Director may determine and vary the size, shape and form and the material of which license plates are made, but each license plate must be of sufficient size to be plainly readable from a distance of 100 feet during daylight. All license plates must be treated to reflect light and to be at least 100 times brighter than conventional painted number plates. When properly mounted on an unlighted vehicle, the license plates, when viewed from a vehicle equipped with standard

1 headlights, must be visible for a distance of not less than 1,500 feet and readable for
2 a distance of not less than 110 feet.

3 5. Every license plate must have displayed upon it:

4 (a) The registration number, or combination of letters and numbers, assigned to
5 the vehicle and to the owner thereof;

6 (b) The name of this State, which may be abbreviated;

7 (c) If issued for a calendar year, the year; and

8 (d) If issued for a registration period other than a calendar year, the month and
9 year the registration expires.

10 6. Each special license plate that is designed, prepared and issued pursuant to
11 NRS 482.367002 must be designed and prepared in such a manner that:

12 (a) The left-hand one-third of the plate is the only part of the plate on which is
13 displayed any design or other insignia that is suggested pursuant to paragraph (f) of
14 subsection 2 of that section; and

15 (b) The remainder of the plate conforms to the requirements for lettering and
16 design that are set forth in this section.

17 **Sec. 5.** NRS 482.276 is hereby amended to read as follows:

18 482.276 Notwithstanding any provision of this chapter to the contrary:

19 1. Any agricultural user who wishes to obtain a license plate and decal to
20 operate a farm tractor or self-propelled implement of husbandry on the highways of
21 this State may submit an application to the Motor Carrier Division of the
22 Department. Each application must be made upon the appropriate form furnished
23 by the Department. The application must include a nonrefundable fee of \$20.50 and
24 evidence satisfactory to the Department that the agricultural user is the holder of a
25 policy of liability insurance which provides at least \$300,000 in coverage for bodily
26 injury and property damage resulting from any single accident caused by the
27 agricultural user while operating the farm tractor or self-propelled implement of
28 husbandry. As soon as practicable after receiving the application, fee and evidence
29 of insurance, the Department shall issue the license plate and decal to the
30 agricultural user to affix to the farm tractor or self-propelled implement of
31 husbandry. A decal issued pursuant to this subsection expires on December 31 of
32 the year in which the Department issues the decal. The license plate and decal are
33 not transferable and must be surrendered or returned to the Department within 60
34 days after:

35 (a) A transfer of ownership or interest in the farm tractor or self-propelled
36 implement of husbandry occurs; or

37 (b) The decal expires pursuant to this subsection and the agricultural user fails
38 to submit an application for renewal pursuant to subsection 2.

39 2. An application for the renewal of a license plate and decal issued pursuant
40 to subsection 1 must be made upon the appropriate form furnished by the
41 Department. The application for renewal must include a nonrefundable fee of \$10
42 and evidence satisfactory to the Department that the agricultural user is the holder
43 of a policy of liability insurance specified in subsection 1. As soon as practicable
44 after receiving the application for renewal, fee and evidence of insurance, the
45 Department shall issue a new decal to affix to the license plate ~~H~~ *or a plate*
46 *reissued pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 482.265*. A decal issued pursuant to this
47 subsection expires on December 31 of the year in which the Department issues the
48 decal.

49 3. A license plate issued pursuant to subsection 1 must be displayed on the
50 farm tractor or self-propelled implement of husbandry in such a manner that the
51 license plate is easily visible from the rear of the farm tractor or self-propelled
52 implement of husbandry. If the license plate is lost or destroyed, the Department
53 may issue a replacement plate upon the payment of a fee of 50 cents. If the decal is

1 lost or destroyed, the Department may, upon the payment of the fee specified in
2 subsection 2, issue a replacement decal for the farm tractor or self-propelled
3 implement of husbandry.

4 4. Notwithstanding any provision of chapter 445B of NRS to the contrary, an
5 agricultural user is not required to obtain a certificate of compliance or vehicle
6 inspection report concerning the control of emissions from a farm tractor or self-
7 propelled implement of husbandry before obtaining a license plate and decal for or
8 operating the farm tractor or self-propelled implement of husbandry pursuant to this
9 section.

10 5. As used in this section, "agricultural user" means any person who owns or
11 operates a farm tractor or self-propelled implement of husbandry specified in
12 subsection 1 for an agricultural use. As used in this subsection, "agricultural use"
13 has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS 361A.030.

14 **Sec. 6.** NRS 482.280 is hereby amended to read as follows:

15 482.280 1. The registration of every vehicle expires at midnight on the day
16 specified on the receipt of registration, unless the day specified falls on a Saturday,
17 Sunday or legal holiday. If the day specified on the receipt of registration is a
18 Saturday, Sunday or legal holiday, the registration of the vehicle expires at
19 midnight on the next judicial day. The Department shall mail to each holder of a
20 certificate of registration a notification for renewal of registration for the following
21 period of registration. The notifications must be mailed by the Department in
22 sufficient time to allow all applicants to mail the notifications to the Department or
23 to renew the certificate of registration at a kiosk or authorized inspection station or
24 via the Internet or an interactive response system and to receive new certificates of
25 registration and license plates, stickers, tabs or other suitable devices by mail before
26 the expiration of their registrations. An applicant may present or submit the
27 notification to any agent or office of the Department.

28 2. A notification:

29 (a) Mailed or presented to the Department or to a county assessor pursuant to
30 the provisions of this section;

31 (b) Submitted to the Department pursuant to NRS 482.294; or

32 (c) Presented to an authorized inspection station or authorized station pursuant
33 to the provisions of NRS 482.281,
34 must include, if required, evidence of compliance with standards for the control
35 of emissions.

36 3. The Department shall include with each notification mailed pursuant to
37 subsection 1:

38 (a) The amount of the governmental services tax to be collected pursuant to the
39 provisions of NRS 482.260.

40 (b) The amount set forth in a notice of nonpayment filed with the Department
41 by a local authority pursuant to NRS 484B.527.

42 (c) A statement which informs the applicant:

43 (1) That, pursuant to NRS 485.185, the applicant is legally required to
44 maintain insurance during the period in which the motor vehicle is registered which
45 must be provided by an insurance company licensed by the Division of Insurance of
46 the Department of Business and Industry and approved to do business in this State;
47 and

48 (2) Of any other applicable requirements set forth in chapter 485 of NRS
49 and any regulations adopted pursuant thereto.

50 (d) A statement which informs the applicant that, if the applicant renews a
51 certificate of registration at a kiosk or via the Internet, he or she may make a
52 nonrefundable monetary contribution of \$2 for each vehicle registration renewed
53 for the Complete Streets Program, if any, created pursuant to NRS 244.2643,

277A.285 or 403.575, as applicable, based on the declaration made pursuant to paragraph (c) of subsection 3 of NRS 482.215. The notification must state in a clear and conspicuous manner that a contribution for a Complete Streets Program is nonrefundable and voluntary and is in addition to any fees required for registration.

(e) Any amount due for reissuance of a license plate or a plate reissued pursuant to subsection 2 of NRS 482.265, if applicable.

4. An application for renewal of a certificate of registration submitted at a kiosk or via the Internet must include a statement which informs the applicant that he or she may make a nonrefundable monetary contribution of \$2, for each vehicle registration which is renewed at a kiosk or via the Internet, for the Complete Streets Program, if any, created pursuant to NRS 244.2643, 277A.285 or 403.575, as applicable, based on the declaration made pursuant to paragraph (c) of subsection 3 of NRS 482.215. The application must state in a clear and conspicuous manner that a contribution for a Complete Streets Program is nonrefundable and voluntary and is in addition to any fees required for registration, and must include a method by which the applicant must indicate his or her intention to opt in or opt out of making such a contribution.

5. An owner who has made proper application for renewal of registration before the expiration of the current registration but who has not received the license plate or plates or card of registration for the ensuing period of registration is entitled to operate or permit the operation of that vehicle upon the highways upon displaying thereon the license plate or plates issued for the preceding period of registration for such a time as may be prescribed by the Department as it may find necessary for the issuance of the new plate or plates or card of registration.

Sec. 7. NRS 482.3667 is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.3667 1. The Department shall establish, design and otherwise prepare for issue personalized prestige license plates and shall establish all necessary procedures not inconsistent with this section for the application and issuance of such license plates.

2. The Department shall issue personalized prestige license plates, upon payment of the prescribed fee, to any person who otherwise complies with the laws relating to the registration and licensing of motor vehicles or trailers for use on private passenger cars, motorcycles, trucks or trailers, except that such plates may not be issued for a full trailer or semitrailer that is registered pursuant to subsection 3 of NRS 482.483.

3. Except as otherwise provided in NRS 482.2065, personalized prestige license plates are valid for 12 months and are renewable upon expiration. ~~These~~

4. Except as otherwise provided in subsection 6, personalized prestige license plates may be transferred from one vehicle or trailer to another if the transfer and registration fees are paid as set out in this chapter.

~~4.4~~ 5. In case of any conflict, the person who first made application for personalized prestige license plates and has continuously renewed them by payment of the required fee has priority.

~~5.4~~ 6. The Department may limit by regulation the number of letters and numbers used, ~~and~~ prohibit the use of inappropriate letters or combinations of letters and numbers ~~+~~

~~6.4~~ *and prohibit the transfer of personalized prestige license plates from one vehicle or trailer to another if such a transfer would result in an inappropriate use of letters or combination of letters and numbers.*

7. The Department shall not assign to any person not holding the relevant office any letters and numbers denoting that the holder holds a public office.

Sec. 8. NRS 482.367008 is hereby amended to read as follows:

482.367008 1. As used in this section, "special license plate" means:

1 (a) A license plate that the Department has designed and prepared pursuant to
2 NRS 482.367002 in accordance with the system of application and petition
3 described in that section;

4 (b) A license plate approved by the Legislature that the Department has
5 designed and prepared pursuant to NRS 482.3747, 482.37903, 482.37905,
6 482.37917, 482.379175, 482.37918, 482.37919, 482.3792, 482.3793, 482.37933,
7 482.37934, 482.37935, 482.379355, 482.379365, 482.37937, 482.379375,
8 482.37938 or 482.37945; and

9 (c) Except for a license plate that is issued pursuant to NRS 482.3757,
10 482.3785, 482.3787 or 482.37901, a license plate that is approved by the
11 Legislature after July 1, 2005.

12 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, and except as
13 otherwise provided in subsection 3, the Department shall not, at any one time, issue
14 more than 30 separate designs of special license plates. Whenever the total number
15 of separate designs of special license plates issued by the Department at any one
16 time is less than 30, the Department shall issue a number of additional designs of
17 special license plates that have been authorized by an act of the Legislature or the
18 application for which has been recommended by the Commission on Special
19 License Plates to be approved by the Department pursuant to subsection 5 of NRS
20 482.367004, not to exceed a total of 30 designs issued by the Department at any
21 one time. Such additional designs must be issued by the Department in accordance
22 with the chronological order of their authorization or approval by the Department.

23 3. In addition to the special license plates described in subsection 2, the
24 Department may issue not more than five separate designs of special license plates
25 in excess of the limit set forth in that subsection. To qualify for issuance pursuant to
26 this subsection:

27 (a) The Commission on Special License Plates must have recommended to the
28 Department that the Department approve the design, preparation and issuance of the
29 special plates as described in paragraphs (a) and (b) of subsection 5 of NRS
30 482.367004; and

31 (b) The special license plates must have been applied for, designed, prepared
32 and issued pursuant to NRS 482.367002, except that:

33 (1) The application for the special license plates must be accompanied by a
34 surety bond posted with the Department in the amount of \$20,000; and

35 (2) Pursuant to the assessment of the viability of the design of the special
36 license plates that is conducted pursuant to this section, it is determined that at least
37 3,000 special license plates have been issued.

38 4. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, on October 1 of each year
39 the Department shall assess the viability of each separate design of special license
40 plate that the Department is currently issuing by determining the total number of
41 validly registered motor vehicles to which that design of special license plate is
42 affixed. The Department shall not determine the total number of validly registered
43 motor vehicles to which a particular design of special license plate is affixed if:

44 (a) The particular design of special license plate was designed and prepared by
45 the Department pursuant to NRS 482.367002; and

46 (b) On October 1, that particular design of special license plate has been
47 available to be issued for less than 12 months.

48 5. If, on October 1, the total number of validly registered motor vehicles to
49 which a particular design of special license plate is affixed is:

50 (a) In the case of special license plates not described in subsection 3, less than
51 1,000; or

52 (b) In the case of special license plates described in subsection 3, less than
53 3,000,

1 ↪ the Director shall provide notice of that fact in the manner described in
2 subsection 6.

3 6. The notice required pursuant to subsection 5 must be provided:

4 (a) If the special license plate generates financial support for a cause or
5 charitable organization, to that cause or charitable organization.

6 (b) If the special license plate does not generate financial support for a cause or
7 charitable organization, to an entity which is involved in promoting the activity,
8 place or other matter that is depicted on the plate.

9 7. If, on December 31 of the same year in which notice was provided pursuant
10 to subsections 5 and 6, the total number of validly registered motor vehicles to
11 which a particular design of special license plate is affixed is:

12 (a) In the case of special license plates not described in subsection 3, less than
13 1,000; or

14 (b) In the case of special license plates described in subsection 3, less than
15 3,000,

16 ↪ the Director shall, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
17 issue an order providing that the Department will no longer issue that particular
18 design of special license plate. ~~Such~~ *Except as otherwise provided in subsection*
19 *2 of NRS 482.265, such* an order does not require existing holders of that particular
20 design of special license plate to surrender their plates to the Department and does
21 not prohibit those holders from renewing those plates.

22 **Sec. 9.** NRS 482.3757 is hereby amended to read as follows:

23 482.3757 1. Except as otherwise provided in this section, the Department
24 shall design, prepare and issue license plates honoring peace officers who have
25 received a medal specified in subsection 3, or the equivalent thereof.

26 2. Each person who qualifies for special license plates pursuant to this section
27 may apply for not more than two sets of plates. If the person applies for a second
28 set of plates for an additional vehicle, the second set of plates must have a different
29 number than the first set of plates issued to the person. Special license plates issued
30 pursuant to this section may be used only on a private passenger vehicle, a
31 noncommercial truck or a motor home.

32 3. The Department shall issue specially designed license plates for any person
33 qualified pursuant to this section who submits an application on a form prescribed
34 by the Department and evidence satisfactory to the Department that the person is:

35 (a) A current or former peace officer who has received one or more of the
36 following medals, or the equivalent thereof, for his or her service as a peace officer:

37 (1) The Medal of Honor;

38 (2) The Purple Heart;

39 (3) The Medal of Valor;

40 (4) The Lifesaving Medal;

41 (5) The Meritorious Service Medal; or

42 (6) The Distinguished Service Medal; or

43 (b) A family member of a person who was:

44 (1) Killed in the line of duty while serving as a peace officer; and

45 (2) Awarded posthumously the Medal of Honor, or the equivalent thereof,
46 for his or her actions as a peace officer.

47 4. A qualifying event described in subsection 3 that entitles a person to
48 special license plates issued pursuant to the provisions of this section is a qualifying
49 event regardless of whether the event occurs or occurred before, on or after July 1,
50 2013.

51 5. If, during a registration year, the holder of a set of special license plates
52 issued pursuant to the provisions of this section disposes of the vehicle to which the
53 plates are affixed, the holder shall:
