ASSEMBLY JOINT RESOLUTION—Recognizing the strategic partnership and bond of friendship with, and expressing the Nevada Legislature's support for, the State of Israel.

1 WHEREAS, The United States of America, having been the first country to
2 recognize the State of Israel as an independent nation and as the principal ally of
3 the State of Israel, has enjoyed a close and mutually beneficial relationship with the
4 State of Israel and her people; and

5 WHEREAS, The State of Israel is the United States of America's closest ally in
6 the Middle East; and

7 WHEREAS, The State of Israel is currently facing significant threats, including
8 the possibility of Iran developing nuclear weapons; and

9 WHEREAS, These threats pose a substantial risk to the United States of America
10 and the other democratic countries of the world; and

11 WHEREAS, The State of Nevada and the State of Israel enjoy a cordial and
12 mutually beneficial relationship; and

13 WHEREAS, The partnership and bond of friendship between the State of Nevada
14 and the State of Israel were further strengthened by Governor Brian Sandoval's
15 trade mission to the State of Israel, which resulted in several Israeli companies
16 considering establishing businesses and other partnerships in the State of Nevada;
17 and

18 WHEREAS, The Governor has appointed an official trade representative to Israel
19 to continue to promote bilateral economic development between the State of
20 Nevada and the State of Israel; and

1 WHEREAS, The Jewish community in the State of Nevada continues to make
2 important contributions to the history and culture of the State of Nevada and
3 supports the State of Israel; now, therefore, be it

4 RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY AND SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, JOINTLY,
5 That the members of the 78th Session of the Nevada Legislature hereby recognize
6 the strategic partnership and bond of friendship between the State of Nevada and
7 the State of Israel; and be it further

8 RESOLVED, That the Nevada Legislature hereby expresses its support for the
9 State of Israel; and be it further

10 RESOLVED, That the Chief Clerk of the Assembly prepare and transmit a copy
11 of this resolution to the Ambassador of Israel to the United States, the Consul
12 General of Israel in Los Angeles, each member of the Nevada Congressional
13 Delegation and the President of the Jewish Federation of Las Vegas; and be it
14 further

15 RESOLVED, That this resolution becomes effective upon passage.
