**SUMMARY** ~~Makes an appropriation to the Department of Motor Vehicles for the modernization of its current platform of information technology and~~ temporarily authorizes the Department of Motor Vehicles to collect a technology fee. (BDR 43-1177)

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AN ACT relating to the Department of Motor Vehicles; ~~creating an account in the Motor Vehicle Fund for system modernization;~~ temporarily authorizing the Department to collect a technology fee; ~~making an appropriation;~~ temporarily increasing the limitation on the percentage of the proceeds of certain fees and charges collected by the Department that are authorized for the Department's costs of administration associated with the collection of those fees and charges; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:**

1 ~~Section 2 of this bill creates the Revolving Account for System Modernization within the~~  
2 ~~Motor Vehicle Fund. Section 6 of this bill makes an appropriation of \$40,526,612 to the~~  
3 ~~Account to pay for the upgrade of the platform of information technology used by the~~  
4 ~~Department of Motor Vehicles.~~ Section 3 of this bill authorizes the Department of Motor  
5 Vehicles to assess a \$1 technology fee on paid transactions, to be deposited into the Account.  
6 ~~Existing law requires that the cost of administration of the Department be not more than 22~~  
7 ~~percent of the license and registration fees collected. (NRS 408.235) Section 6.5 of this bill~~  
8 ~~provides that section 3 becomes effective when the Director of the Department determines~~  
9 ~~that sufficient resources are available to enable the Department to carry out the provisions of~~  
10 ~~section 3. Section 5 of this bill excludes the money spent from the Account for the technology~~  
11 ~~upgrade from the costs of administration, used by the Department to pay the expenses~~  
12 ~~associated with implementing, upgrading and maintaining the platform of information~~  
13 ~~technology used by the Department. Section 7 of this bill authorizes the collection of the~~  
14 ~~technology fee until June 30, 2020.~~

15 Under existing law, all the proceeds from the imposition of any license or  
16 registration fee and other charges regarding the operation of a motor vehicle on any  
17 public highway, road or street in Nevada, except costs of administering the collection  
18 thereof, is required to be used exclusively for the construction, maintenance and repair  
19 of the State's public highways. (Nev. Const. Art. 9, § 5; NRS 408.235) Existing law limits  
20 the amount of such proceeds that are authorized to be used for costs of administration to

21           22 percent of the proceeds collected. (NRS 408.235) Section 5 of this bill temporarily  
22           increases this limitation for costs of administration to 27 percent during the period in  
23           which the Department is collecting the technology fee.

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THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN  
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1           **Section 1.** Chapter 481 of NRS is hereby amended by adding thereto the  
2 provisions set forth as sections 2 and 3 of this act.

3           **Sec. 2.** ~~1. The Revolving Account for System Modernization is hereby~~  
4           ~~created in the Motor Vehicle Fund.~~

5           ~~2. The Director shall administer the Account. The money in the Account~~  
6           ~~must be expended to pay for any costs associated with the implementation,~~  
7           ~~upgrade and maintenance of the platform of information technology used by the~~  
8           ~~Department.~~

9           ~~3. The Director may apply for and accept any legislative appropriations,~~  
10           ~~fees, gifts, grants, donations or other sources of money for deposit in the~~  
11           ~~Account.~~

12           ~~4. The interest and income earned on the money in the Account, after~~  
13           ~~deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to the Account.~~

14           ~~5. Any money remaining in the Account at the end of the fiscal year does~~  
15           ~~not revert to the State General Fund or the State Highway Fund, and the balance~~  
16           ~~of the Account must remain in the Account and be carried forward to the next~~  
17           ~~fiscal year.~~

18           ~~6. The expenditure of money in the Account is not deemed to be costs of~~  
19           ~~administration of the Department for the purposes of NRS 408.235.~~

20           **7. As used in this section:**

21           ~~(a) "Information technology" has the meaning ascribed to it in NRS~~  
22           ~~442.050.~~

23           ~~(b) "Platform" means a group of technologies that are used as a base upon~~  
24           ~~which other applications, processes or technologies are developed.]~~ (Deleted by  
25           amendment.)

26           **Sec. 3.** *The Department shall add a nonrefundable technology fee of \$1 to*  
27           *the existing fee for any transaction performed by the Department for which a fee*  
28           *is charged. The technology fee must be [deposited in the Revolving Account for*  
29           *System Modernization created by section 2 of this act], used to pay the expenses*  
30           *associated with implementing, upgrading and maintaining the platform of*  
31           *information technology used by the Department.*

32           **Sec. 4.** NRS 481.079 is hereby amended to read as follows:

33           481.079 1. Except as otherwise provided by **section 3 of this act or any**  
34           **other** specific statute, all taxes, license fees and money collected by the Department  
35           must be deposited with the State Treasurer to the credit of the Motor Vehicle Fund.

36           2. If a check or any other method of payment accepted by the Department in  
37           payment of such fees is returned to the Department or otherwise dishonored upon  
38           presentation for payment:

39           (a) The drawer or any other person responsible for payment of the fee is  
40           subject to a fee in the amount established by the State Controller pursuant to NRS  
41           353C.115 in addition to any other penalties provided by law; and

42           (b) The Department may require that future payments from the person be made  
43           by cashier's check, money order, traveler's check or cash.

1       3. The Department may adjust the amount of a deposit made with the State  
2 Treasurer to the credit of the Motor Vehicle Fund for any cash shortage or overage  
3 resulting from the collection of fees.

4       **Sec. 5.** NRS 408.235 is hereby amended to read as follows:

5       408.235 1. There is hereby created the State Highway Fund.

6       2. Except as otherwise provided by a specific statute, the proceeds from the  
7 imposition of any:

8           (a) License or registration fee and other charges with respect to the operation  
9 of any motor vehicle upon any public highway, city, town or county road, street,  
10 alley or highway in this State; and

11           (b) Excise tax on gasoline or other motor vehicle fuel,

12           → must be deposited in the State Highway Fund and must, except for costs of  
13 administering the collection thereof, be used exclusively for the administration,  
14 construction, reconstruction, improvement and maintenance of highways as  
15 provided for in this chapter.

16       3. The interest and income earned on the money in the State Highway Fund,  
17 after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to the Fund.

18       4. Costs Except as otherwise provided in section 2 of this act, costs of  
19 administration for the collection of the proceeds for any license or registration fees  
20 and other charges with respect to the operation of any motor vehicle must be  
21 limited to a sum not to exceed ~~22~~ 27 percent of the total proceeds so collected.

22       5. Costs of administration for the collection of any excise tax on gasoline or  
23 other motor vehicle fuel must be limited to a sum not to exceed 1 percent of the  
24 total proceeds so collected.

25       6. All bills and charges against the State Highway Fund for administration,  
26 construction, reconstruction, improvement and maintenance of highways under the  
27 provisions of this chapter must be certified by the Director and must be presented to  
28 and examined by the State Board of Examiners. When allowed by the State Board  
29 of Examiners and upon being audited by the State Controller, the State Controller  
30 shall draw his or her warrant therefor upon the State Treasurer.

31       7. The money deposited in the State Highway Fund pursuant to NRS  
32 244A.637 and 354.59815 must be maintained in a separate account for the county  
33 from which the money was received. The interest and income on the money in the  
34 account, after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to the account.  
35 Any money remaining in the account at the end of each fiscal year does not revert  
36 to the State Highway Fund but must be carried over into the next fiscal year. The  
37 money in the account:

38           (a) Must be used exclusively for the construction, reconstruction, improvement  
39 and maintenance of highways in that county as provided for in this chapter;

40           (b) Must not be used to reduce or supplant the amount or percentage of any  
41 money which would otherwise be made available from the State Highway Fund for  
42 projects in that county; and

43           (c) Must not be used for any costs of administration or to purchase any  
44 equipment.

45       8. The money deposited in the State Highway Fund pursuant to NRS 482.313  
46 must be maintained in a separate account. The interest and income on the money in  
47 the account, after deducting any applicable charges, must be credited to the  
48 account. Any money remaining in the account at the end of each fiscal year does  
49 not revert to the State Highway Fund but must be carried over into the next fiscal  
50 year. The money in the account:

51           (a) Must be used exclusively for the construction, reconstruction, improvement  
52 and maintenance of highways as provided for in this chapter; and

1                   (b) Must not be used for any costs of administration or to purchase any  
2 equipment.

3        Sec. 6. ~~[T]here is hereby appropriated from the State Highway Fund to the  
4 Revolving Account for System Modernization created by section 2 of this act the  
5 sum of \$40,536,613 for upgrading the current platform of information technology  
6 used by the Department of Motor Vehicles.]~~ **(Deleted by amendment.)**

7        Sec. 6.5. ~~[U]pon determining that sufficient resources are available to enable  
8 the Department of Motor Vehicles to carry out the provisions of section 3 of this  
9 act, the Director of the Department shall notify the Governor and the Director of the  
10 Legislative Counsel Bureau of that fact, and shall publish on the Internet website of  
11 the Department notice to the public of that fact.]~~ **(Deleted by amendment.)**

12        Sec. 7. ~~[H] This [section and sections 1, 2 and 4 to 6.5, inclusive, of this]~~  
13 act ~~[become]~~ **becomes** effective on July 1, 2015.  
14        2. Section 3 of this act becomes effective on the date on which the  
15 Department of Motor Vehicles publishes on its Internet website the notice required  
16 pursuant to section 6.5 of this act.] **, and expires by limitation on June 30, 2020.**
