SUMMARY—Authorizes a nonresident who is a member of the
Armed Forces of the United States and is stationed in
Nevada to enroll in the Program for the Education of
Motorcycle Riders. (BDR 43-71)

AN ACT relating to motorcycles; authorizing a nonresident who is a
member of the Armed Forces of the United States and is
stationed in Nevada to enroll in the Program for the
Education of Motorcycle Riders; and providing other
matters properly relating thereto.

Legislative Counsel's Digest:

1 Existing law requires the Director of the Department of Public Safety to
2 establish the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders to provide training
3 for Nevada residents in the proper habits and skills necessary for the safe operation
4 of a motorcycle. (NRS 486.363-486.381) This bill allows a nonresident who is a
5 member of the Armed Forces of the United States and who is stationed in Nevada
6 to enroll in the Program.



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN
SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 **Section 1.** NRS 486.373 is hereby amended to read as follows:
2 486.373 1. A resident of this State who holds a motorcycle
3 driver's license or a motorcycle endorsement to a driver's license or
4 who is eligible to apply for such a license or endorsement , *or a*
5 *nonresident who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United*
6 *States, a reserve component thereof or the National Guard and*
7 *who is stationed at a military installation located in Nevada,* may
8 enroll in the Program.
9 2. The Director shall establish a fee of not more than \$150 for
10 the Program.
11 **Sec. 2.** This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
