SUMMARY—Authorizes a nonresident who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States and is stationed in Nevada to enroll in the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders. (BDR 43-71)

AN ACT relating to motorcycles; authorizing a nonresident who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States and is stationed in Nevada to enroll in the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders; and providing other matters properly relating thereto.

**Legislative Counsel's Digest:** 

Existing law requires the Director of the Department of Public Safety to establish the Program for the Education of Motorcycle Riders to provide training for Nevada residents in the proper habits and skills necessary for the safe operation of a motorcycle. (NRS 486.363-486.381) This bill allows a nonresident who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States and who is stationed in Nevada to enroll in the Program.





## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEVADA, REPRESENTED IN SENATE AND ASSEMBLY, DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. NRS 486.373 is hereby amended to read as follows: 486.373 1. A resident of this State who holds a motorcycle driver's license or a motorcycle endorsement to a driver's license or who is eligible to apply for such a license or endorsement, or a nonresident who is a member of the Armed Forces of the United States, a reserve component thereof or the National Guard and who is stationed at a military installation located in Nevada, may enroll in the Program.

- 9 2. The Director shall establish a fee of not more than \$150 for 10 the Program.
- 11 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective upon passage and approval.
