BDR 14-469 reduces the percentage of expense the counties pay to create pre-sentence investigation reports. Currently, pre-sentence investigation reports are funded seventy percent by the counties and thirty percent with state General Fund. This bill changes the percentage paid by counties to thirty percent and the state General Fund would pay seventy percent for pre-sentence investigation reports.
