## **Explanation**

Section 1, subsection 3 directs NDOT and local jurisdictions to erect signs warning motorists entering a pedestrian safety zone designated by the respective authority having jurisdiction that violations of various traffic infractions within such pedestrian safety zones at intersections, in school zones, at any other location where pedestrians may lawfully cross a road, and where motorists will be subject to enhanced fines. Installation of advance warning signs for each direction of travel at the beginning and end of a pedestrian safety zone would result in the installation of at least four such signs; two for each direction of travel.

The remaining twenty nine (29) sections of the bill amend applicable sections of NRS Chapter 484 add enhanced fines for violations that occur in pedestrian safety zones as provided by this bill.

Altough a definitive estimate cannot be determined at this time, NDOT is initiating a more aggressive pedestrian safety program which includes additional advanced warning signs. Any signage required by this BDR to enhance pedestrian safety will be absorbed under NDOT's enhanced pedestrian safety program.
