BDR 43-72 provides for enhanced and/or revised penalties for certain traffic violations in pedestrian safety zones, crosswalks and intersections and U-turns in a school zone or school crossing zone. The bill will require staff of the General Services Division (GSD) to create two new Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs) and to modify numerous other NOCs in order for law enforcement agencies to communicate offense information electronically with Nevada courts. The NOC modification process is time- and labor-intensive for GSD staff. The cumulative impact to the division's Criminal History Repository resulting from the creation of new or revised NOCs must be considered. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in the 2016-2017 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
