The provisions of this bill establishing a new class of hunting license for the disabled without a hunter education requirement has a fiscal impact on the agency. This is an unprecedented license type that does not currently exist for either the Nevada Wildlife Data System (NWDS) or the Application Hunt System (AHS). Both systems would require programming, testing, and training for personnel by the contractor responsible for maintaining these systems. \$6,000 is the rough estimated provided by the contractor to implement this change.
