BDR 24-614, Sections 2,3, and 5 provide that knowingly and willfully filing a declaration of candidacy, acceptance of candidacy or declaration of residency with any false statement is punishable as a category C felony. If this bill is enacted, it would require the General Services Division (GSD) to create, modify, and deactivate several Nevada Offense Codes (NOCs). The NOCs are the mechanism used by Nevada criminal justice agencies to transfer charge and conviction information between disparate electronic records systems. The cumulative impact to GSD, Criminal History Repository resulting from the updates must be considered. GSD requests to return to the Nevada Legislature's Interim Finance Committee in the 2016-2017 biennium should workload increases necessitate additional staffing.
