This was originally submitted to the Department of Administration as a policy BDR; however, we have determined it does have a fiscal impact. The projected impact does not affect any of DMV's operating budgets. As a result of the passage of SB399 during the 77th Legislative session, the Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) suppliers filed complaints with the Legislative Counsel Bureau (LCB) stating the bill imposed a tax increase on LNG. Although the Department was previously charging .27 per gallon on LNG prior to SB399, a decision had been made in 2011 allowing LNG suppliers to use the conversion rate in statute for Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG aka propane). Conversion rates in statute for alternative fuels do not align with standardized measurements, thus creating confusion for both the industry and Department on how to properly report and tax the gaseous fuels.

The Department has worked closely with LCB to correct the language and set standard measurements for gaseous fuels which coincides with federal standards. Fuel tax rates requested in this bill reflect the rate currently collected on LPG and Compressed Natural Gas (CNG), which is actually lower than the current statutory rate of .22 for LPG and .21 for CNG. Section 2 of the bill recommends a graduated tax increase to bring the tax from the current rate being collected as a result of the conversion language. Section 3 of the bill aligns the conversion factors to federal measurement standards and includes a measurement for LNG.

System programming for the changes in this bill are estimated at 40 hours and will be absorbed by the Department.
