The DMV is currently required to offer males ages 18-26 the option to register with the Selective Service by submitting their personal information to the Selective Service System when they apply for a driver's permit or license. This bill requires the DMV to submit this information and inform customers that their application authorizes the DMV to do so. It also expands the practice to include applicants for a DAC who fall into this demographic.

The proposed implementation date of 7/1/2015 cannot be met as a result of the estimated programming hours needed to complete the requirements. Due to the Department's existing programming priorities and mandates, funding for a computer systems Master Services Agreement programmer(s) is included in this fiscal note. The estimated contract programming hours are 767 at \$100 per hour (\$76,700). This is a one-time cost.
