Comment: A.B 62 (BDR 19-298) revises various provisions relating to veterans, including establishment of certain veteran preferences in state contacts. Section 5 of the bill would require each state agency, including the Nevada Commission on Ethics, to submit all solicitations for the award of any contract to the Office of Economic Development for its record-keeping and notification requirements of local businesses which are owned by a veteran. The Commission has rare need to issue any contracts for goods or services as its operations are adequately staffed with full time employees and funded under its legislatively approved budget. Only once in the last 5 years has the Commission solicited a contract for temporary professional legal services to assist with a special and unique project. Should the Commission need to solicit any contractual goods or services, the requirement to provide the solicitation to the Office of Economic Development would require minimal staff time and effort and have no fiscal impact on the agency. Commission staff is adept at issuing various notifications and filing information with fellow government agencies. Section 28 of the bill would require certain state agencies to report certain data to the Interagency Council on Veterans Affairs. However, the Commission is not included in the list of agencies subject to this requirement. Accordingly, this section and the remaining sections of the bill have no fiscal impact on the Commission.
