SB 144 authorizes the governing bodies of NDOT and local jurisdictions to designate pedestrian safety zones on highways or roads under their respective jurisdictions. NDOT and local jurisdictions are directed to erect advance warning signs (as well as at the end of such zones) informing motorists that they are entering such a pedestrian safetzone where they can be subject to enhanced fines for various traffic law violations committed within these zones. Although a definitive estimate of the fiscal impact of this bill cannot be determined at this time, NDOT is initiating a more aggressive pedestrian safety program which includes additional advance warning signs. Any signage and other costs attributable to this bill will be absorbed under NDOT's enhanced pedestrian safety program.
