The State Public Charter School Authority (SPCSA) anticipates a fiscal impact if BDR 34-235 is approved as submitted. However, SPCSA is not able to provide estimated fiscal impact due to multiple variables which are unclear at this time. For compliance with this BDR, independent charter schools expect a fiscal impact yet do not currently have access to the fiscal note system. SPCSA revenue is directly tied to student enrollment in charter schools within its jurisdiction. Fiscal impact to SPCSA may be realized for items such as, but not limited to: time and staffing required to research and ensure viability of revised charter school operating budgets; and student enrollment at viable campuses.
