Section 2 of this legislation authorizes the Commission on Special License Plates to request an audit by the Legislative Auditor of any charitable organization that receives fees from the sale of special license plates if the Commission has specific concerns that are described in that section. Although there would be no direct fiscal impact to the Audit Division of the Legislative Counsel Bureau, the requirement could impact the workload of the Division. If the Commission requests an audit of a charitable organization, the requirement to complete that audit would result in that audit taking priority over other audits on the audit program approved by the Legislative Commission and would delay the completion of the audits on that program.
