BDR 43-529, as amended, proposes to allow the Commission on Special License Plates to investigate and request an audit to be conducted by a Legislative Auditor of any charitable organization receiving funds from the sale of license plates if the Commission believes they have cause or they have received a complaint. It also requires charitable organizations applying for a specialty license plate to include a budget of the proposed operating and administrative expenses of the organization and to include a budget report in the annual information required to be sent to the Commission. It further provides that an organization, once notified their plate will be issued, must submit the procedures for awarding grants to the Commission for review and approval and that all records, including federal tax returns, are considered public records and must be made available for public inspection.

This BDR becomes effective on July 1, 2015.

The agency has reviewed this BDR and determined that there is no fiscal impact.
