This bill would revise provisions related to data collection, maintenance, and sharing for students attending public schools, charter schools, and university schools for profoundly gifted students. It appears that the proposed legislation would impact the Department of Education, the board of trustees for each school district, the governing body of a charter school, and the governing body of a university school for profoundly gifted pupils, which according to NRS 392A.050, is a public school.

It does not appear that the proposed legislation has an impact on the NSHE or its institutions. Therefore, if enacted, it appears that the proposed legislation would have no fiscal impact on the NSHE or its institutions.
