This bill would require the Secretary of State (SOS) to purchase and maintain application software that would make the entire SOS website (over 2,000 pages) mobile friendly/compatible. The application software would also be required to support the submittal of any information or forms related to elections from mobile devices.

The bill would also require the SOS to develop a system that would allow the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) and other voter registration agencies to electronically submit voter registration information to the SOS. The storage and transmission of this information is required by the bill to be secure and stored as individual electronic voter registration application documents. The bill further requires to SOS to electronically submit all voter registration application documents received from the DMV and other voter registration agencies to the appropriate county clerk. In addition, the bill requires the SOS to use the electronic voter registration applications of people already registered to vote to correct the statewide voter registration list.

Pursuant to the bill, the mobile compatibility upgrade to the website, as well as the electronic voter registration system, must be completed by January 1, 2016 (for DMV submissions only; all other voter registration agencies are required to come online by January 1, 2017). This would give the SOS approximately 6 months to complete both processes. Current IT staffing levels and work load do not allow adequate ability to comply with the provisions of this bill. As a result, contractors would be needed to develop the electronic voter registration system and to convert the SOS's website to full mobile compatibility. Hardware and software purchases would also have to be made, and two new full-time positions would have to be created, to support the system. Detailed cost estimates can be found on the attached spreadsheet. Position costs are calculated in NEBS, BA 1050, W99, DU E226 and E227.
