The Nevada State Board of Pharmacy anticipates that BDR 54-869 would cost the Board an estimated \$16,000 over the next few years. The Bill would create a new licensing category, which would require the development of substantial new regulations (including AG and LCB costs), a new license application and new methods for tracking applicant training. The Board does not anticipate that the fees it could charge to applicants for this new category would off-set the expenses the category would incur, as Board does not anticipate a large number of applicants.
