The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR # 14-955 which revises NRS 202.254 and 202.360 to expand the universe of persons who would be in unlawful possession or control of a firearm. The amendment of the law will broaden the set of persons that could be convicted of felonies that, in turn, would be admitted to the NDOC. The Nevada Department of Corrections cannot estimate how many individuals in the State of Nevada have been disallowed accesses to weapons by courts in Nevada or in other states or how many have been adjudicated as mentally ill by Nevada courts or courts in other states. However, the change in the criteria could increase the size of the prison population, but the magnitude of the increase cannot be determined.
