BDR 14-955 (SB240) relating to public safety. Existing law authorizes a private person who wishes to transfer a firearm to another person to request the Central Repository to perform a background check on the person who wishes to acquire a firearm. Section 14 of this bill prohibits the Central Repository from charging a fee to perform a background check for such a transfer. Because the General Services Division (GSD) has no way to estimate the number of private party background checks passage would provide, a definitive cost estimate cannot be determined at this time. However, should workload increases necessitate additional staffing, GSD through the Director of the Department of Public Safety, as authorized within Section 14, subsection 7, will return to the Interim Finance Committee to request an allocation from the Contingency Account to cover the costs incurred by the Department to carry out the provisions of Section 14, subsection 5 of this bill.
