This bill proposes to expand the requirement for board of trustees for local school districts and governing bodies of charter schools to expand instruction regarding financial literacy to pupils enrolled in middle school and junior high school. Additionally, the bill expands the specific skills that should be included in the instruction and directs that the instruction be included within the study of mathematics.

It does not appear that this legislation would have a direct impact on the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE). While several NSHE institutions have partnered with local school districts to offer educational programs to high school aged students, the students remain under the administrative oversight of the local school district.

If enacted, it appears that this legislation would have no fiscal impact on the NSHE or its institutions.
