The Department of Corrections has reviewed BDR # 16-568, and the NDOC doesn't have any offenders in its database that were convicted of soliciting minors for prostitution. Violations of NRS 201.354 are misdemeanor offenses, and offenders convicted under this statute are not in the NDOC's database because they are supervised by county agencies. Similar offenses are found in the NDOC's database for offenders convicted of violating NRS 201.300 and 201.340 (pandering or attempted pandering with a child, furnishing, or transporting a child). These offenders are C and B felons and are serving lengthier sentences than the proposed sentences for the first and second offenses. Thus, passage of the law should have a negligible impact on the NDOC.
