BDR 43-396 requires the Department to assign a Vehicle Identification Number (VIN) to a motor vehicle manufactured not later than 1942, if the owner makes such a request, and submits an affidavit to the Department stating that the VIN, if any, is not accessible or readable without substantial dismantling of the motor vehicle. The BDR has an effective date of January 1, 2016.

The Department currently assigns VINs to vehicles but would need to revise its VIN Assignments policy and procedure, create an affidavit and make it available to the public. Programming may be necessary in order to be able to record the submittal of an affidavit in the DMV Application. Programming is estimated at 88 hours which would be accomplished by Department staff.

The Department has reviewed the BDR and determined that there would be no fiscal impact.
