BDR 16-1005 - Provides certain protections and services for victims of human trafficking; Sections one and two require a law enforcement officer to make assessments and provide certain information to qualifying victims. As the bill is written the Training Division for the Department of Public Safety will create a four to six hour online training course to provide necessary training and information to law enforcement officers to know how to identify qualifying victims and what information to provide to those victims. Additionally, the law enforcement officer will be required to take time away from his or her primary duties to complete the required training. However, the Department of Public Safety has determined that there is no fiscal impact.
