NDOT has reviewed the provisions of BDR 16-1005, noting that Section 5, subsections 3, 4 and 5 (page 10) direct NDOT and the Dept. of Business and Industry to design and fabricate suitable public warning signs for use at highway rest areas, picnic areas and such to alert motorists to report incidents involving potential human trafficking. While several signs would need to be prepared, installed and maintained, NDOT would be able to comply incrementally without additional expenditure authority.
